

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AMENDING CHAPTER 111 OF THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 111.04(b) SETTING THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE FEE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, KENTUCKY:**

**SECTION I**

Chapter 111 of the City's Municipal Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by amending Section 111.04(b) to read as follows:

111.04 BUSINESS TAXATION.

(B) *Rate.* The Occupational License Fee that is levied and imposed by this chapter is at the rate of:

- (1) *Employees.* 1.5% of all compensation earned by an employee for labor, work or services provided in the city.
- (2) *Those not employees.* 0.075% of gross receipts of everybody, other than employees, who is engaged in any franchise, trade, occupation, profession or other business in the city.

**SECTION II**

The effective date of this ordinance shall be January 1, 2016.

**SECTION III**

Any and all Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.


**SECTION IV**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication, which may be in summary form, and recording, according to law.



NOTICE OF ADOPTION, TITLE AND SUMMARY  
OF VILLA HILLS ORDINANCE 2015-10

This summary is made pursuant to the authority of KRS 83A.060(9), which permits the City to publish a summary of an Ordinance in lieu of the publication of the full Ordinance itself. Said summary follows:

A. The title of the Ordinance is: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AMENDING CHAPTER 111 OF THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 111.04(b) SETTING THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE FEE.

B. The authority for the Ordinance is KRS 92.280 and Kentucky Constitution § 181.

C. The Ordinance sets forth the following sections

1. Provides that the Occupational License Fee for employees is increased from 1% to 1.5%: 111.04 BUSINESS TAXATION
2. Rate. The Occupational License Fee that is levied and imposed by this chapter is at the rate of:
3. Employees: 1.5% of all compensation earned by an employee for labor, work or services provided in the city.
4. Those not employees: 0.075% of gross receipts of everybody, other than employees, who is engaged in any franchise, trade, occupation, profession or other business in the city.
5. Provides that Ordinance is effective January 1, 2016.
6. Provides that conflicting ordinances are repealed
7. Provides that the Ordinance shall be published in summary.

D. The Ordinance was passed July 29, 2015 and becomes effective January 1, 2016.
