

ORDINANCE 2014 - 18 Draft Ordinance 2014-Z

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AMENDING SECTION 112.01(A) OF THE VILLA HILLS CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REMOVE THE RESTRICTION ON THE SALE OF ALCOHOL ON ELECTION DAYS.

WHEREAS, The Kentucky General Assembly authorized the sale of alcohol when the election polls were open on election days with the approval of the local jurisdiction;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

That section 112.01(A) of the Villa Hills Code of Ordinances is amended as follows:

112.01 HOURS OF SALE.

(A) Pursuant to the authority of KRS 244.290 and KRS 244.480, no distilled spirits, wine, or malt beverages may be sold at retail, whether by the drink or by package, in the city between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. of any day. [~~In addition, no distilled spirits, wine, or malt beverages may be sold at retail in the city during the hours when any polls are open in the city on any election day.~~]

SECTION II

Any and all Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION III


The provisions of this ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, and may be published in summary form, and recording, according to law.
