



**Public Hearing on Proposed 2016 Property Tax Rates
September 14, 2016**

Mayor Irvin T. "Butch" Callery called the September 14, 2016 City of Villa Hills Public Hearing to order at 6:15 p.m. at the Dennis M. Stein Municipal Building, 719 Rogers Road, Villa Hills, Kentucky. Mayor Callery led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Bohman took the roll. Those in attendance:

A quorum was present.

Mr. Metzger read the special meeting notice for the public hearing into the record and received waiver of notice signed by all Councilmembers.

City Administrator/Clerk Bohman testified that the city is holding the public hearing to comply with Chapter 132 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes. He noted that the Public Valuation Administrator reassessed the City of Villa Hills and property values in the city increased 2.2% over last year. Mr. Bohman stated that the proposal is to keep the tax rates the same in order to realize that increase. He reported that keeping the rate the same was budgeted.

The floor was opened for public comments by Mayor Callery. There were no public comments. There being no further comments, the meeting proceeded to legislation.

Mr. Metzger gave a second reading to draft Ordinance 2016-I, setting the 2016 property tax rates at .214 per \$100 for real property, .073 for personal property, deadlines, interest and penalties. Mr. Ringo commented that this was discussed during the budget process and is not a surprise. Mr. Waugaman made a motion to adopt, seconded by Ms. Koenig. A roll call vote was taken as follows:



Motion carried 5-0. This will become Ordinance 2016-10.


With no further comments or business, Mr. Waugaman made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Ringo. Motion carried by voice vote all in favor.
