

**Public Hearing on Proposed 2017 Property Tax Rates  
September 13, 2017**


A quorum was present.


City Administrator/Clerk Bohman testified that the city is holding the public hearing to comply with Chapter 132 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes. Mr. Bohman explained the definition of compensating rate found and statute and reported the revenue projection for both the compensating and +4% allowable rate. He reported that the compensating rate was \$0.214 per \$100 and the +4% allowable rate was \$0.222 per \$100. Mr. Bohman noted that taking the +4% allowable rate was budgeted and if a lower rate was adopted it would result in a budget deficit.

The floor was opened for questions or comments from Council members. There being no comments or question from Council members, the Mayor open the floor to public comments. There were no public comments. There being no further business for the public hearing, Mayor Callery closed the public hearing and proceeded to the regularly scheduled Caucus meeting that immediately followed.
