# CRESCENT SPRINGS VILLA HILLS FIRE AND EMS

## **OVERVIEW OF 2018**

During the 2018 Calendar year the Crescent Springs-Villa Hills Fire Department responded to 1406 emergency dispatches, an increase of 112 calls from 2017.

1031 Ambulance responses (increase of 35)

605 Fire Responses (increase of 25)

Both fire and ambulance calls are at an all time high.

The Crescent Springs-Villa Hills Fire Department protects nearly 12,000 residents and 1.5 billion dollars in property.

The Crescent Springs-Villa Hills Fire Department remains an ISO class 3 rating on a scale from 1 to 10 (1 being the best).

In 2018 there were 0 civilian fire deaths and 0 civilian fire injures injuries.

In 2018 year there were 0 firefighter casualties and 0 firefighting injuries, 0 workers compensation claims.

## 2018 PROPERTY LOSS DUE TO FIRE

In 2018 the total property loss due to fire was \$1,299,000.

Property loss in 2017 was \$95,750, this is an increase of \$1,203,250. \$1,280.000 of the losses, the 2 homes were fully involved in fire upon our arrival.


