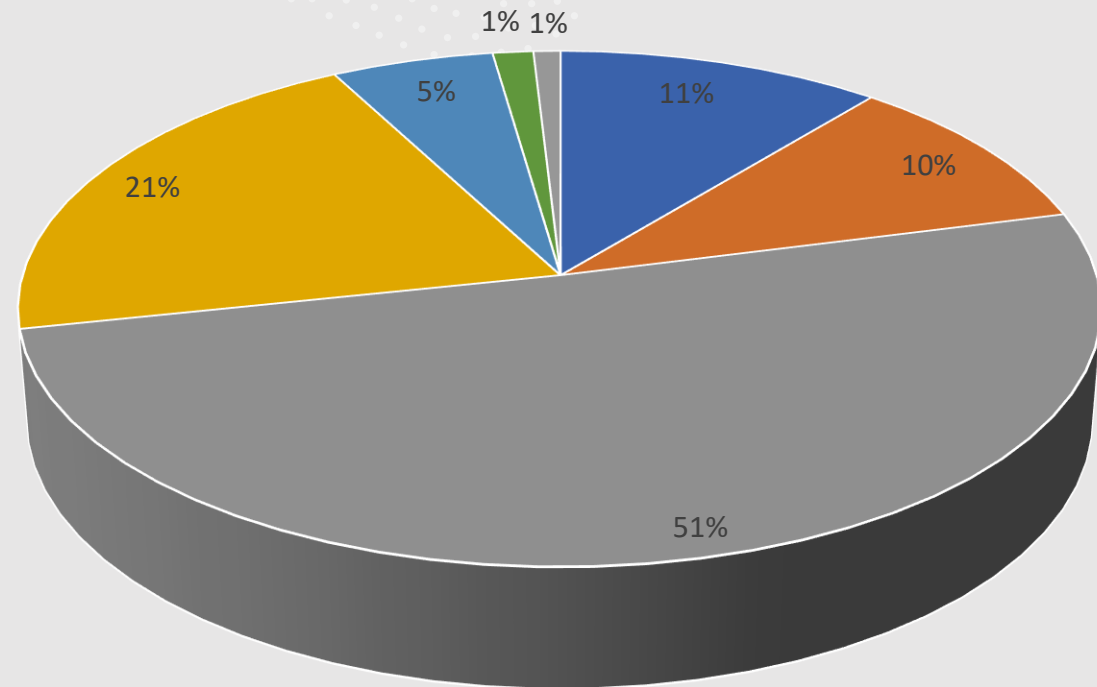

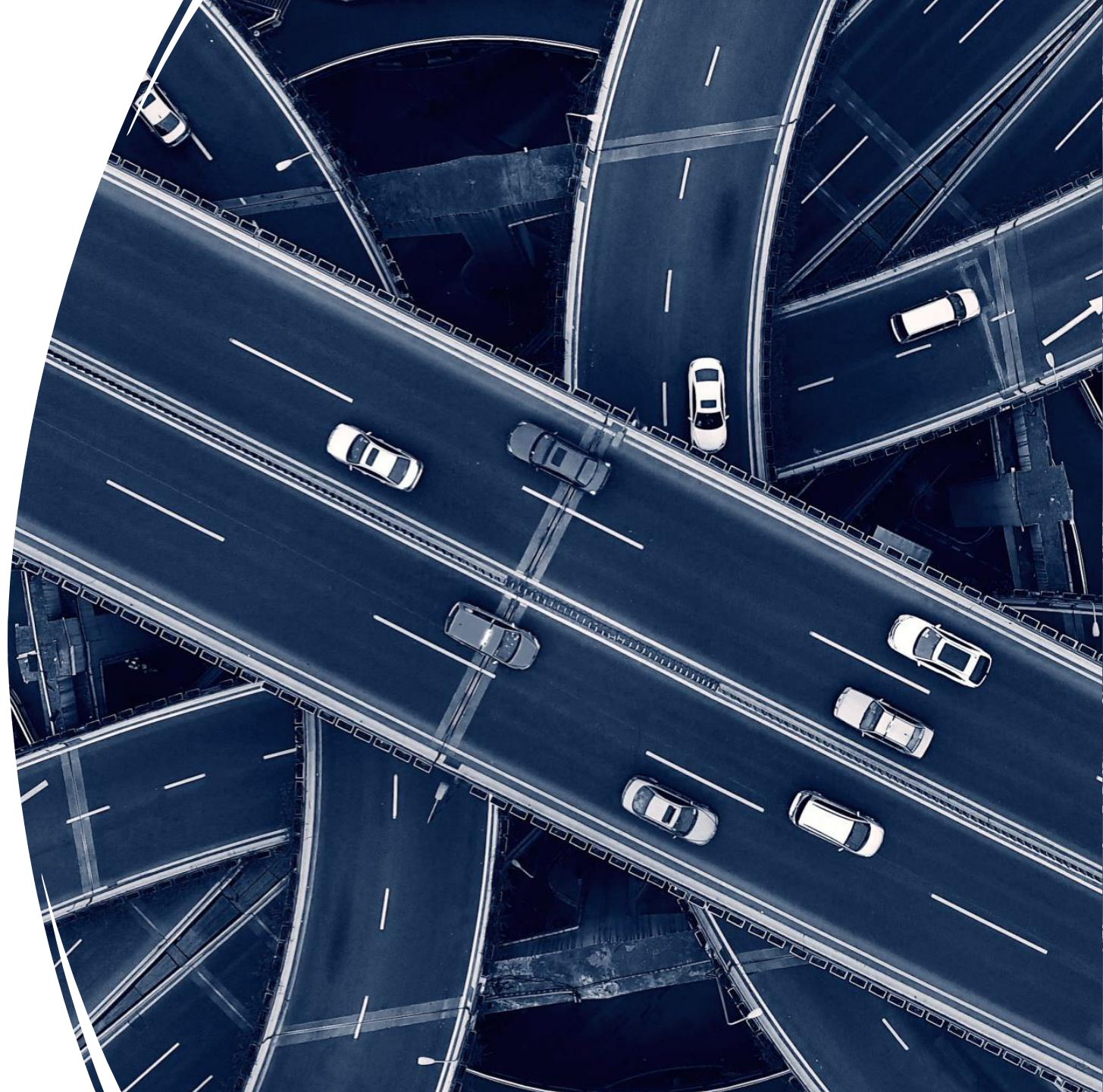

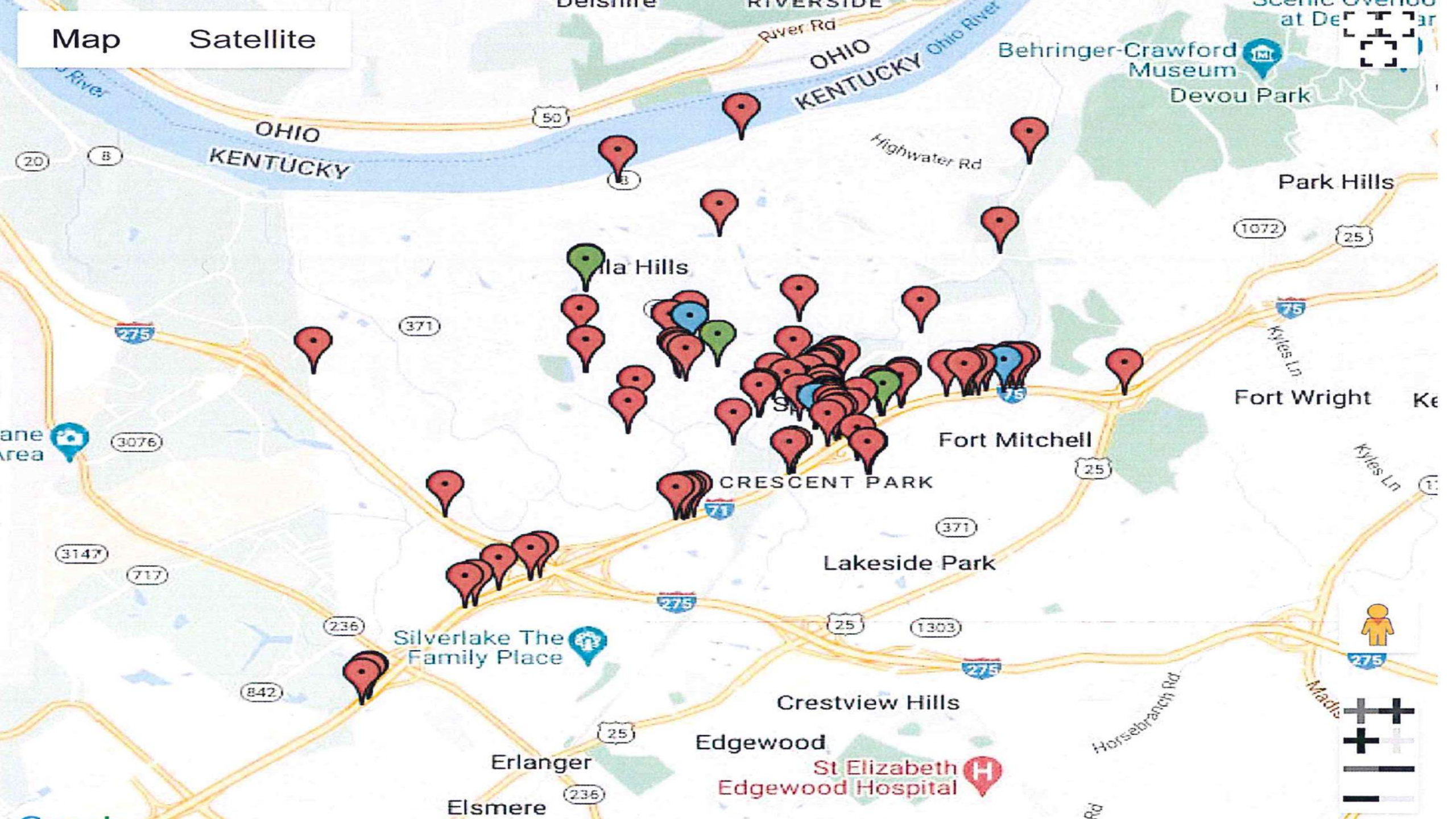

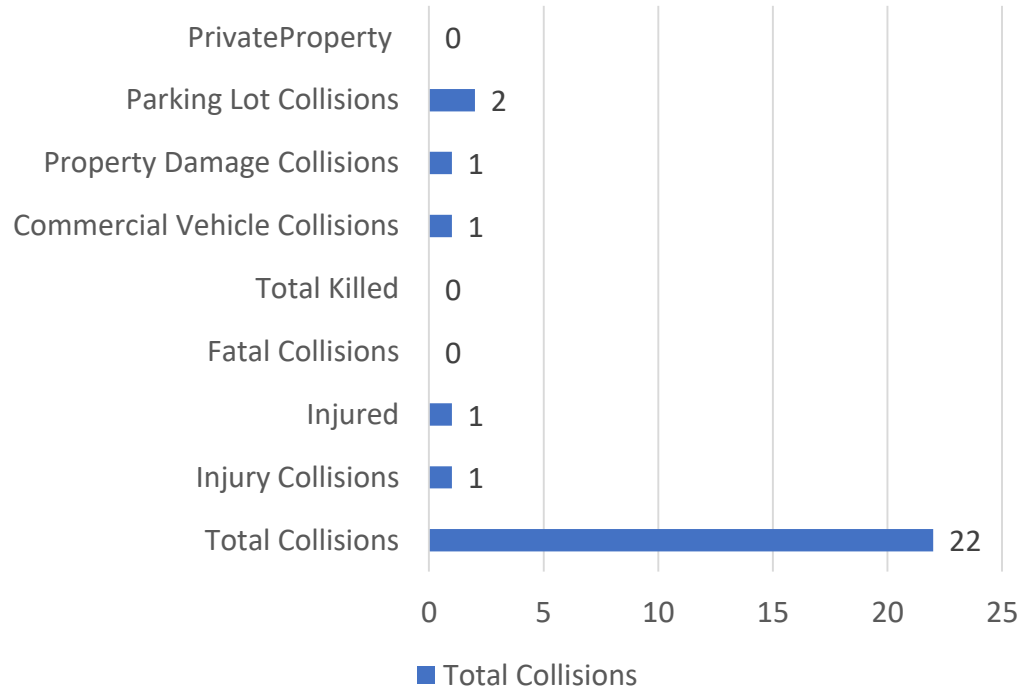


Map

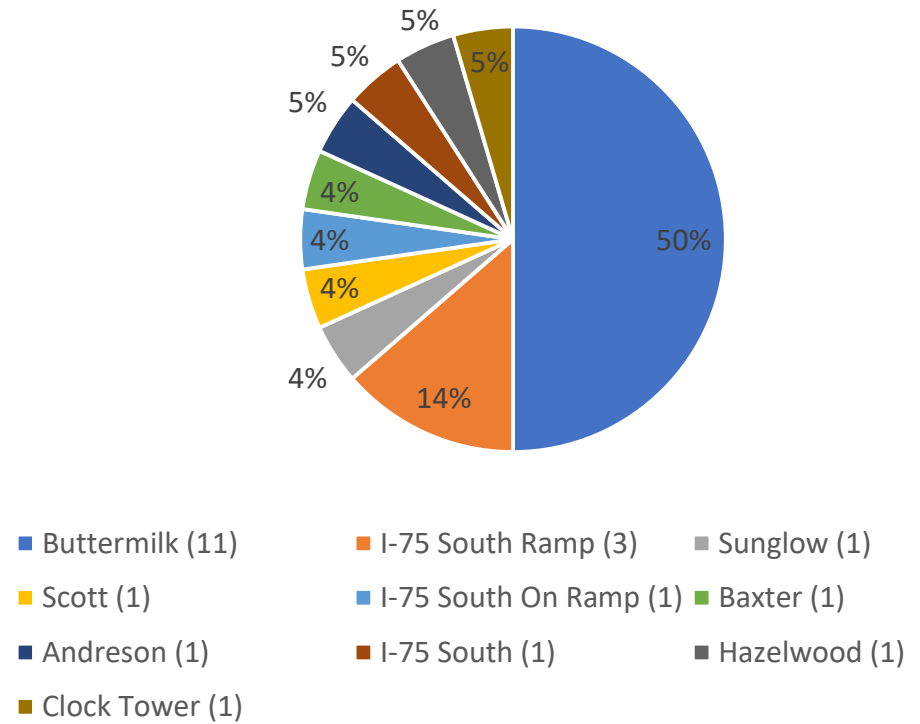
Satellite

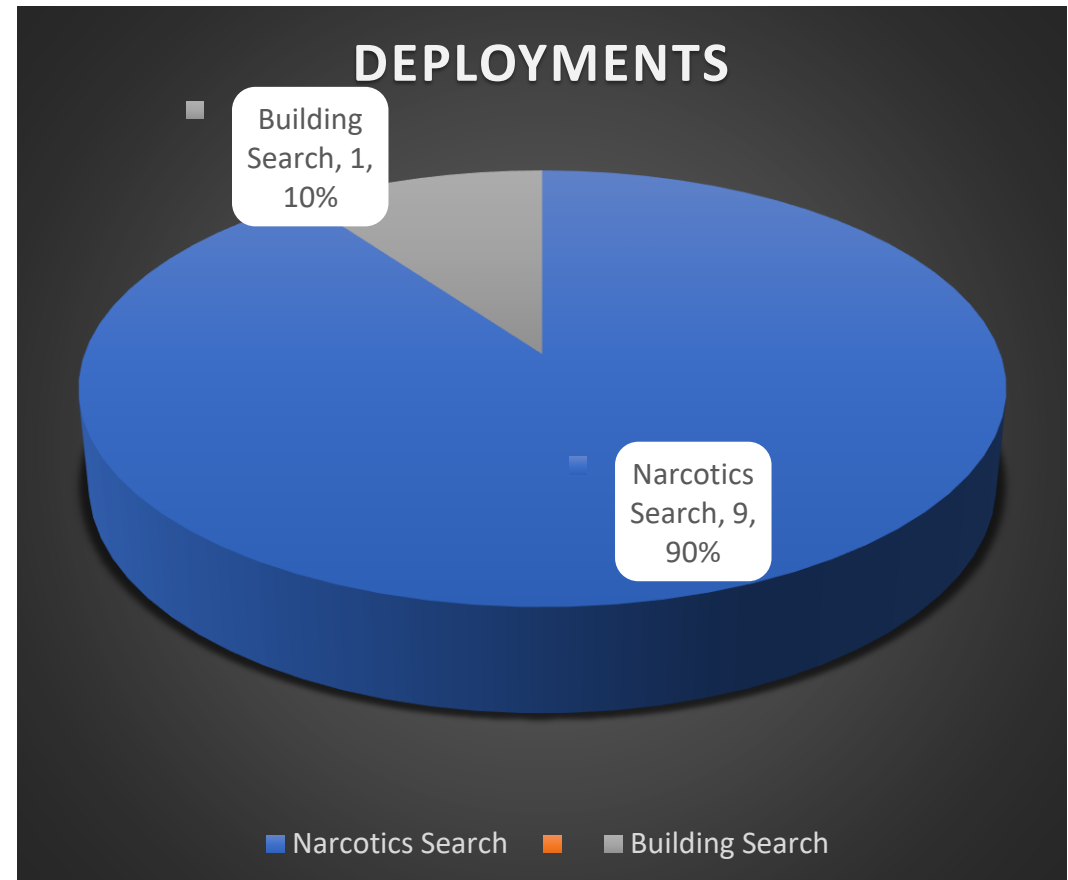

Pressed Pills – 2,000 Units



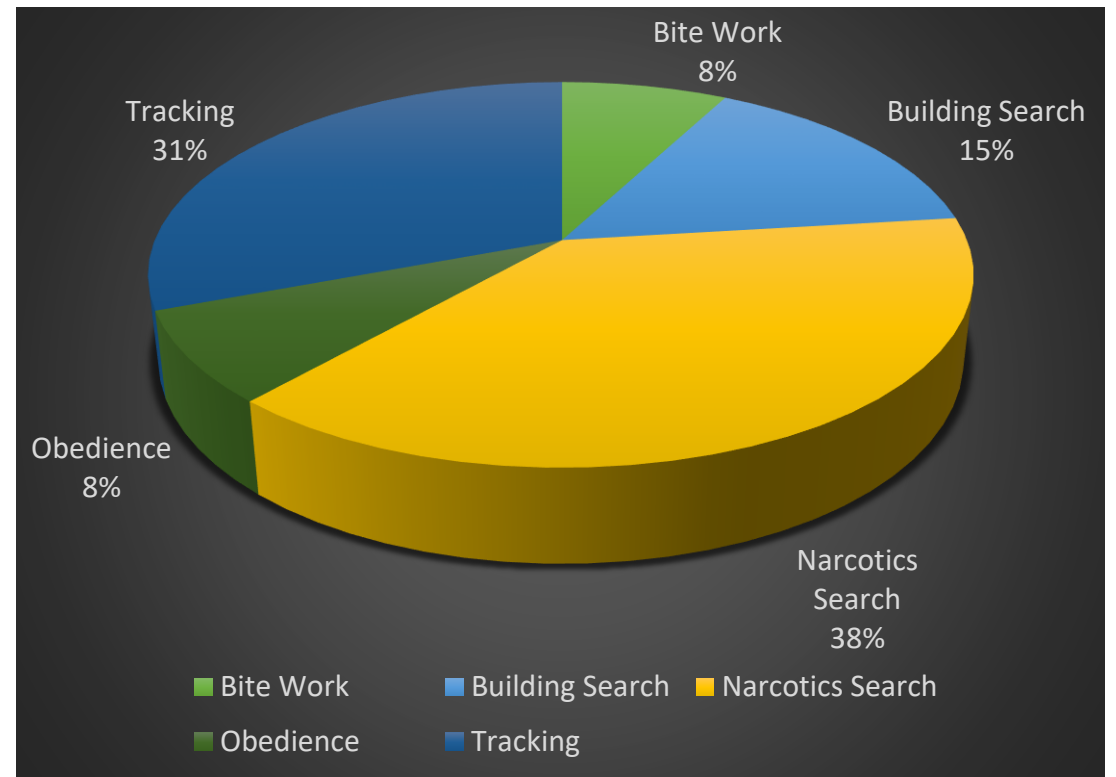
