AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS FOR POLICE SERVICES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Cities of Villa Hills and Crescent Springs, in Kenton County Kentucky, have entered into and twice amended an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the provision of police services in 2018, 2020 and 2021; and

WHEREAS, both cities agree that using a funding formula is an equitable manner to split the operational costs of police services between the cities; and

WHEREAS, both cities agree that amending the original agreement for a third time would be cumbersome and create confusion with inoperative sections and retain errors and typos; and


WHEREAS, The members of the City Council have reviewed the proposed Second Interlocal Agreement and have concluded that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Villa Hills, Kentucky;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS:

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Villa Hills the Second Interlocal Agreement with the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, to provide police services to the City of Crescent Springs. A copy of said Second Interlocal Agreement appears as Exhibit "A" and is subject to begin July 1, 2024 subject to the approval of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, and the Attorney General or Department of Local Government.


