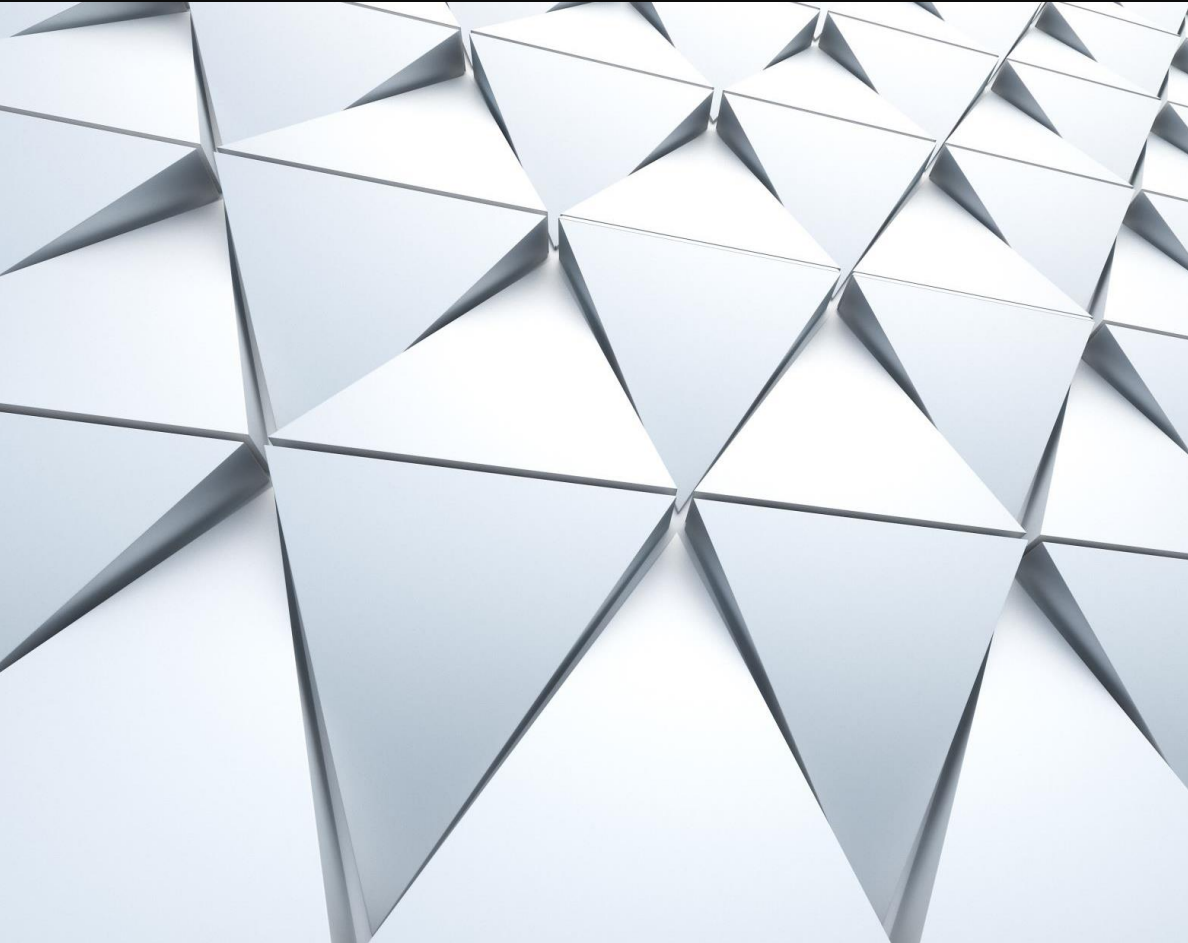

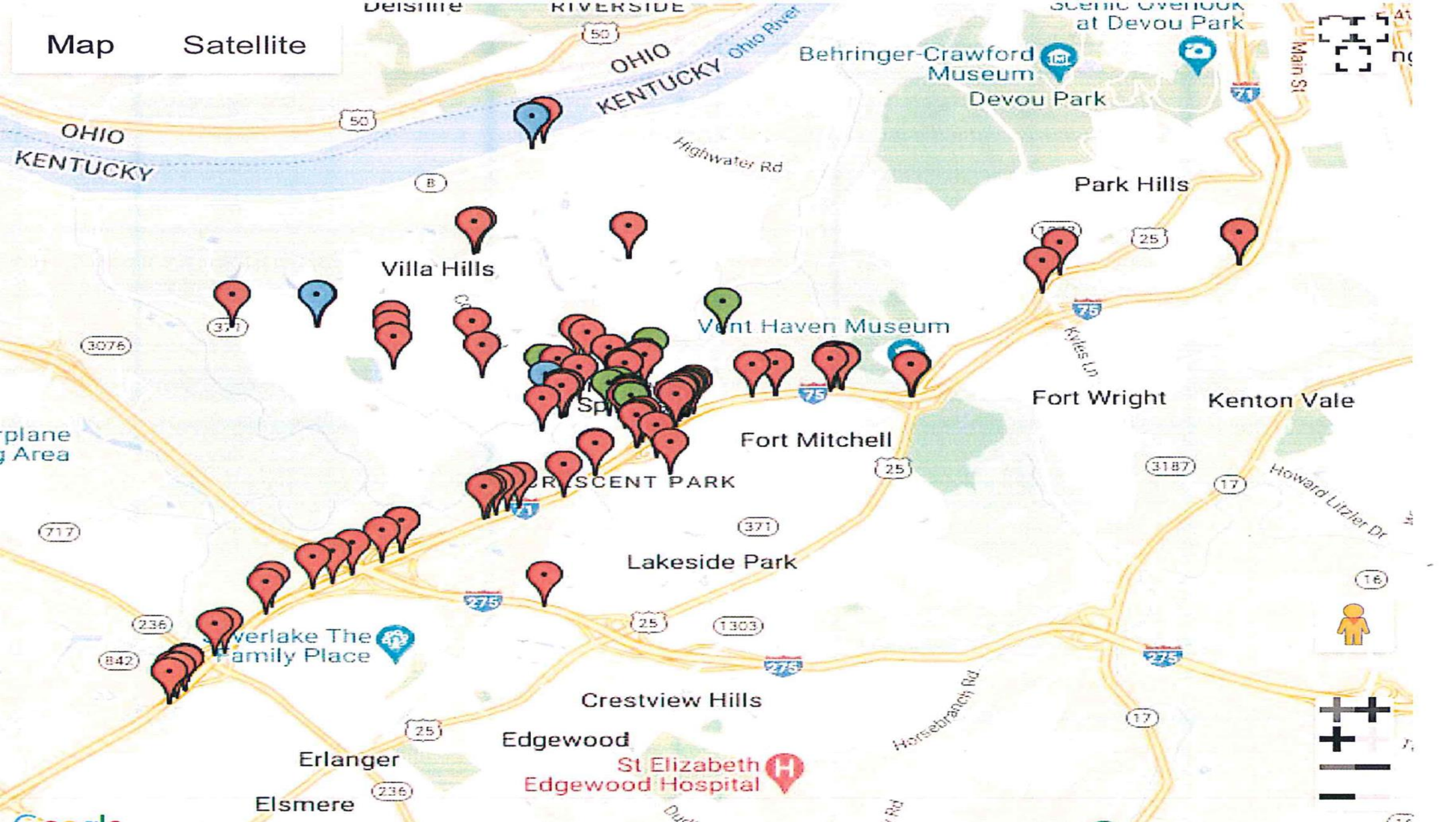

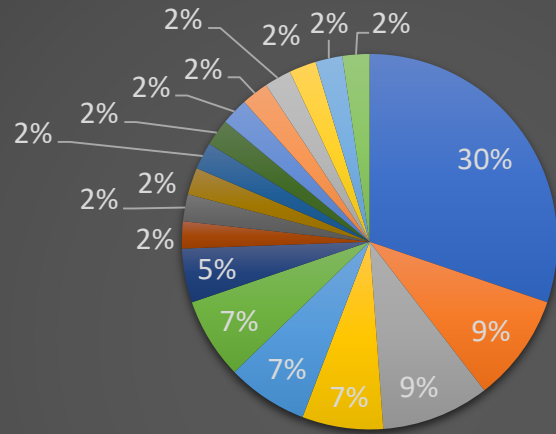

2023-04592	•(Child Pornography)- Grand Jury Subpoenas being sent. Commonwealth coordinating with South Carolina.
2023-05519	•(Sexual Assault 1 st) – CACs continue to be completed, interviews, evidence collected. Case sent to Commonwealth for review.
2023-08911	•(Incest and Narcotics Investigation) – Initial report taken. Interviews conducted. Waiting for more info from victim.
2023-09075	•(Theft/Federal charges for Practicing Medicine without a License)- Working with Boone County and Independence. DEA adopting case. Case continues to develop.
2023-11846	•(Theft >\$10,000)- Interviewing employees of business. Investigation continues.

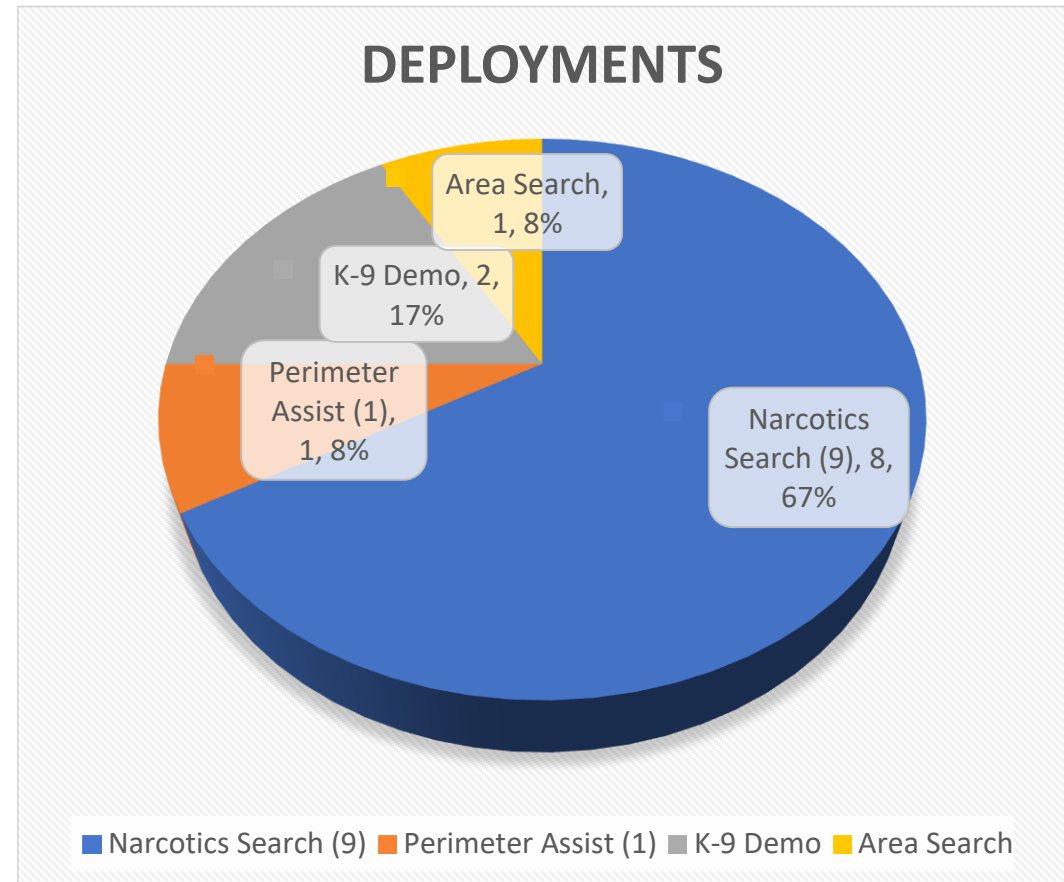

➤ Assisted agencies with arrest of homicide suspects from Independence.



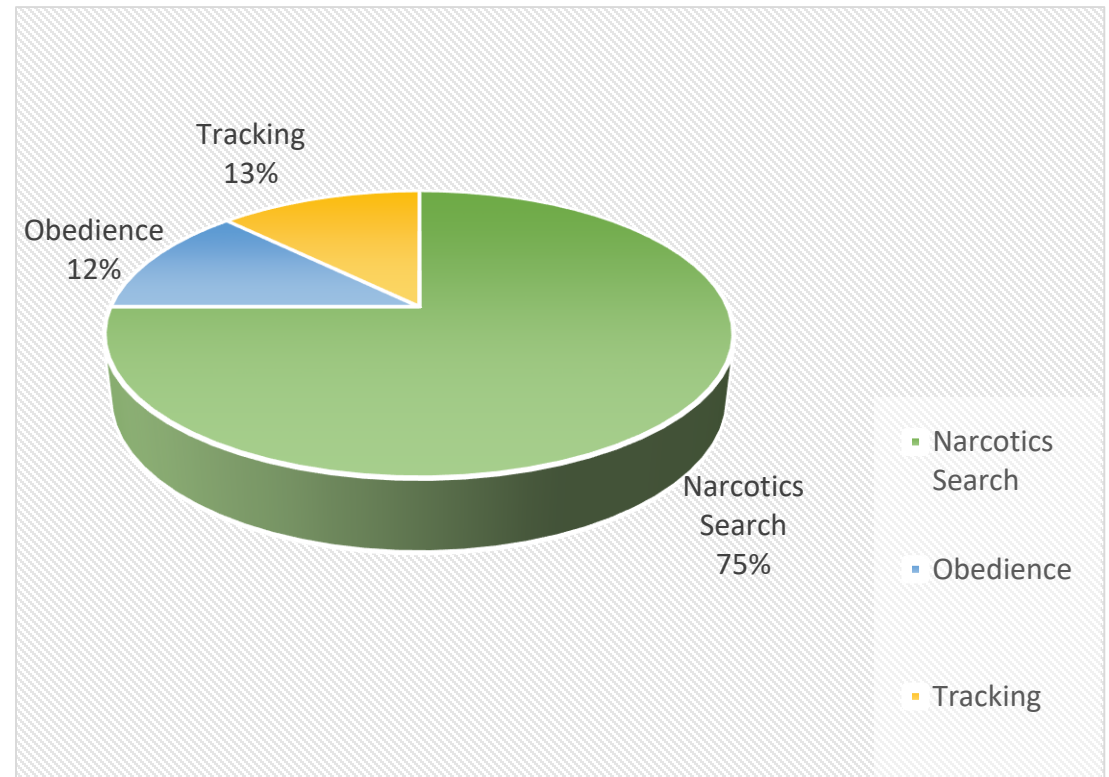
