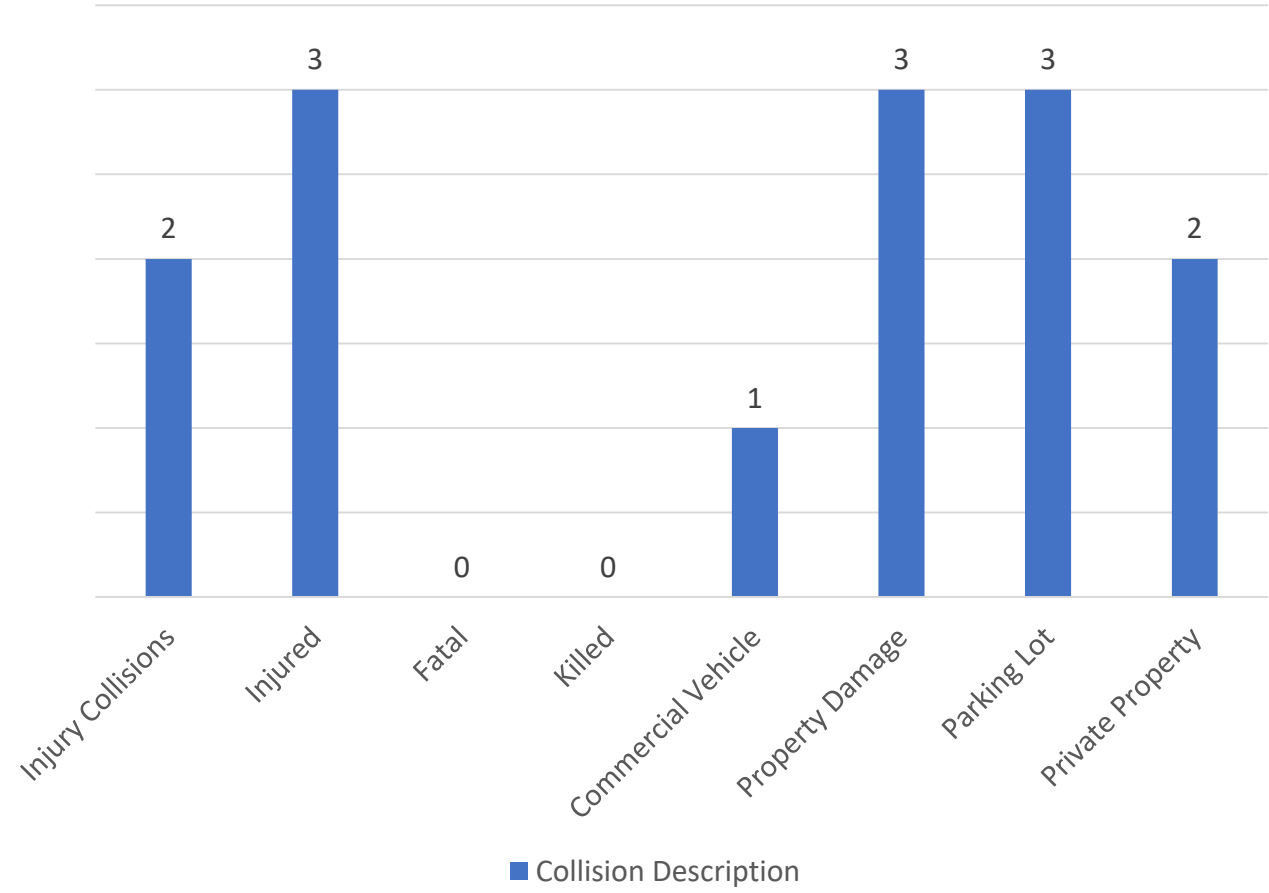

## ACTIVE CASES

**2023-10277**

•(Criminal Abuse 1<sup>st</sup>) – Interviews Conducted. Confession gained. Commonwealth Reviewing. Still under review.

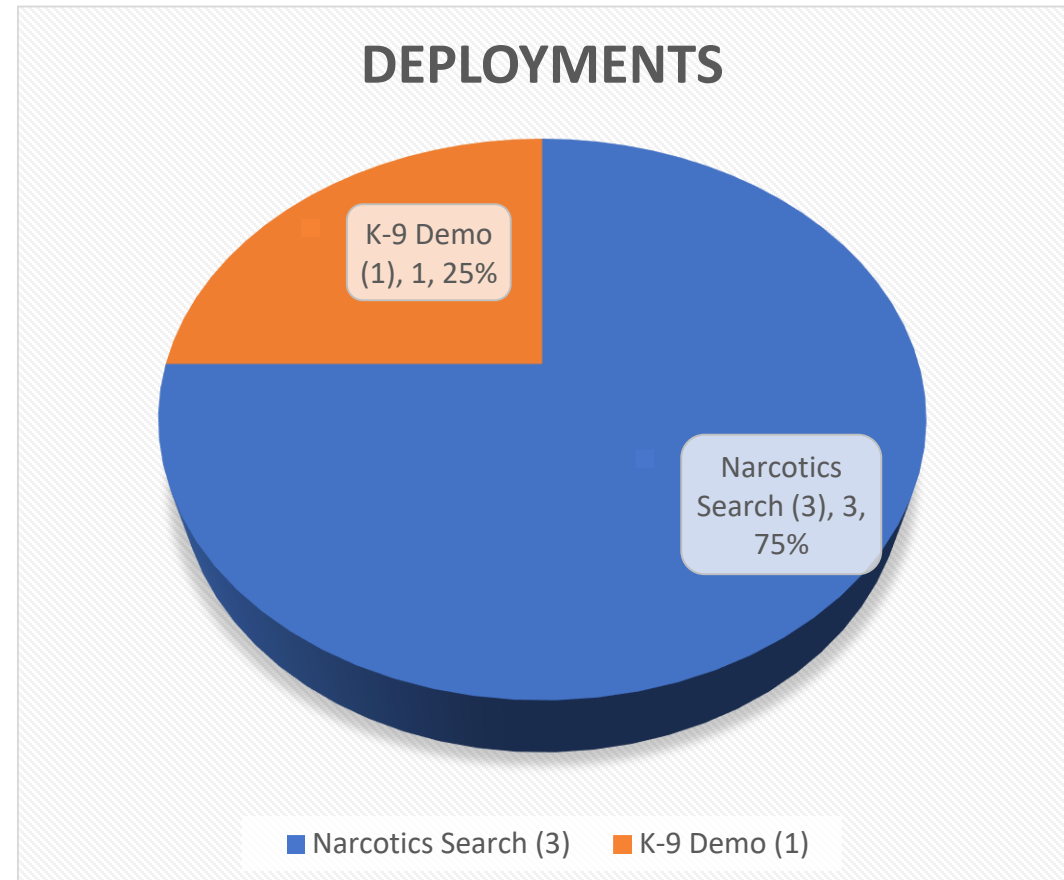

- Received high praise and evaluations from various Master Trainers

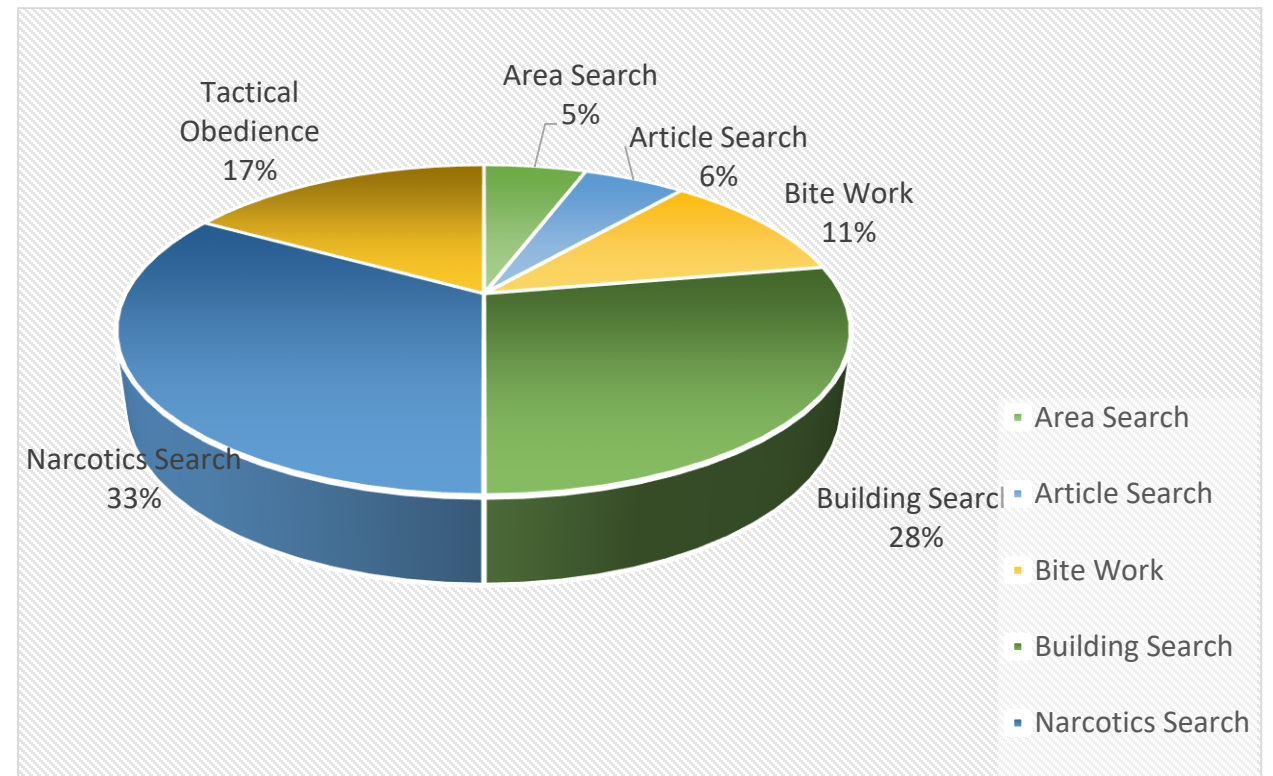

# DEPARTMENT NEWS



- Current Staffing Levels – 14 (Down 1)
- Unit 143 involved in minor traffic collision (Scheduled to be repaired on 11/06/23)
- Unit 144 involved in traffic collision. Suspects fled from Ft. Wright Police in stolen vehicle and struck Unit 144 in the front. Juveniles fled on foot but were apprehended. Vehicle to be assessed for potential repairs (if able).
- As of 09/26/23 – Paul Miller Ford states that two 2 Ford Interceptors are “In Production.”
- Picked up New 2023 Dodge Durango at Don Franklin Auto and is currently at 911 Fleet for upfit and graphics
- Requested potential costs of exchanging purchased equipment for Fords to the Dodge Durango (Exploring options)
- Received Two (2) new Portable Breath Tests Instruments (PBT) from Office of Highway Safety
- Axon In-Car Camera Fleet Video Recorders to be installed on 10/10 and 10/11.
- Demo with PM/AM HCM Company for new software for Accreditation.
- Began arduous process for Accreditation that is due June 2024.
- New Evidence Software and Inventory System has been installed and will go live in October.
