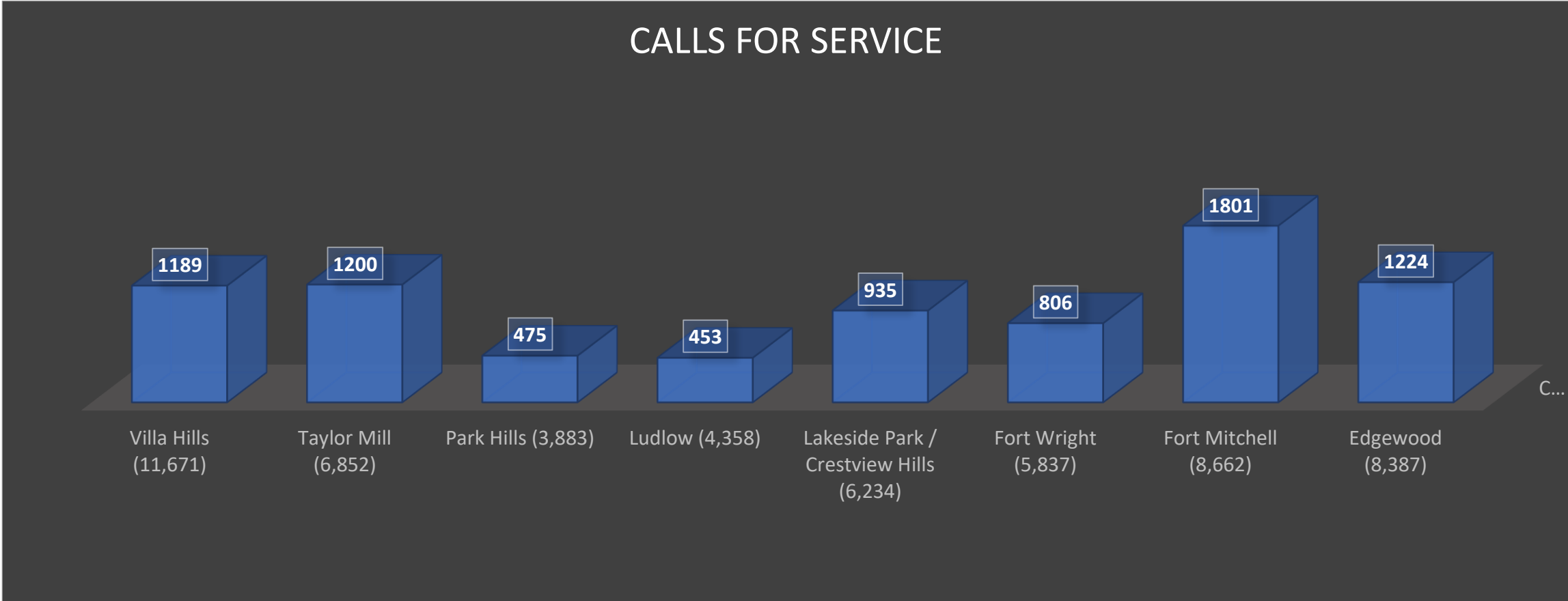

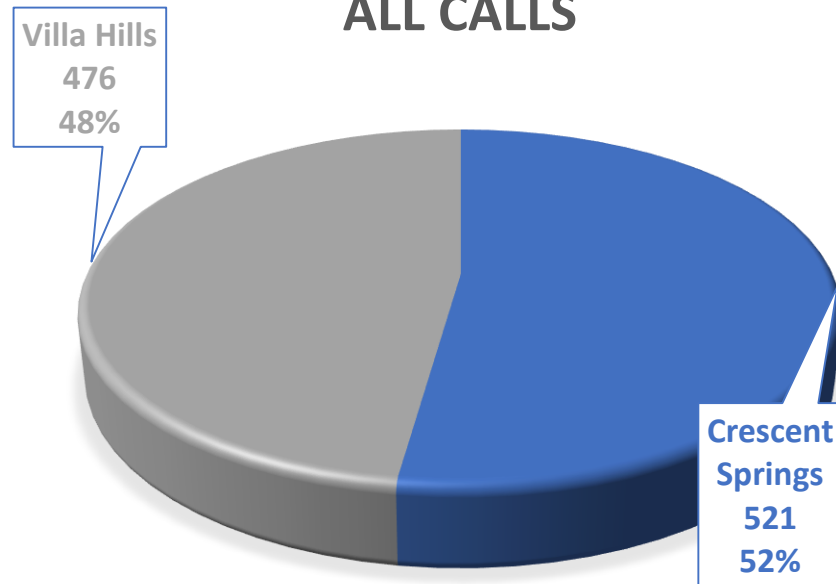


NOVEMBER 2023 CALLS FOR SERVICE BY CITY

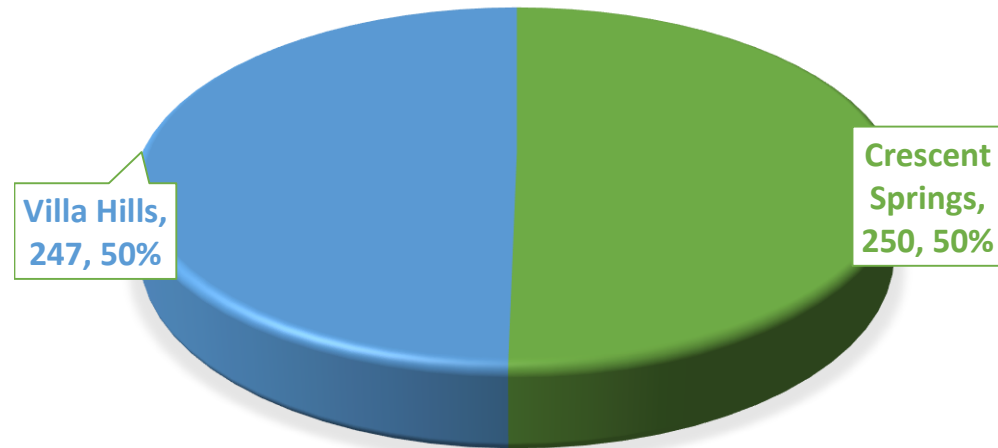

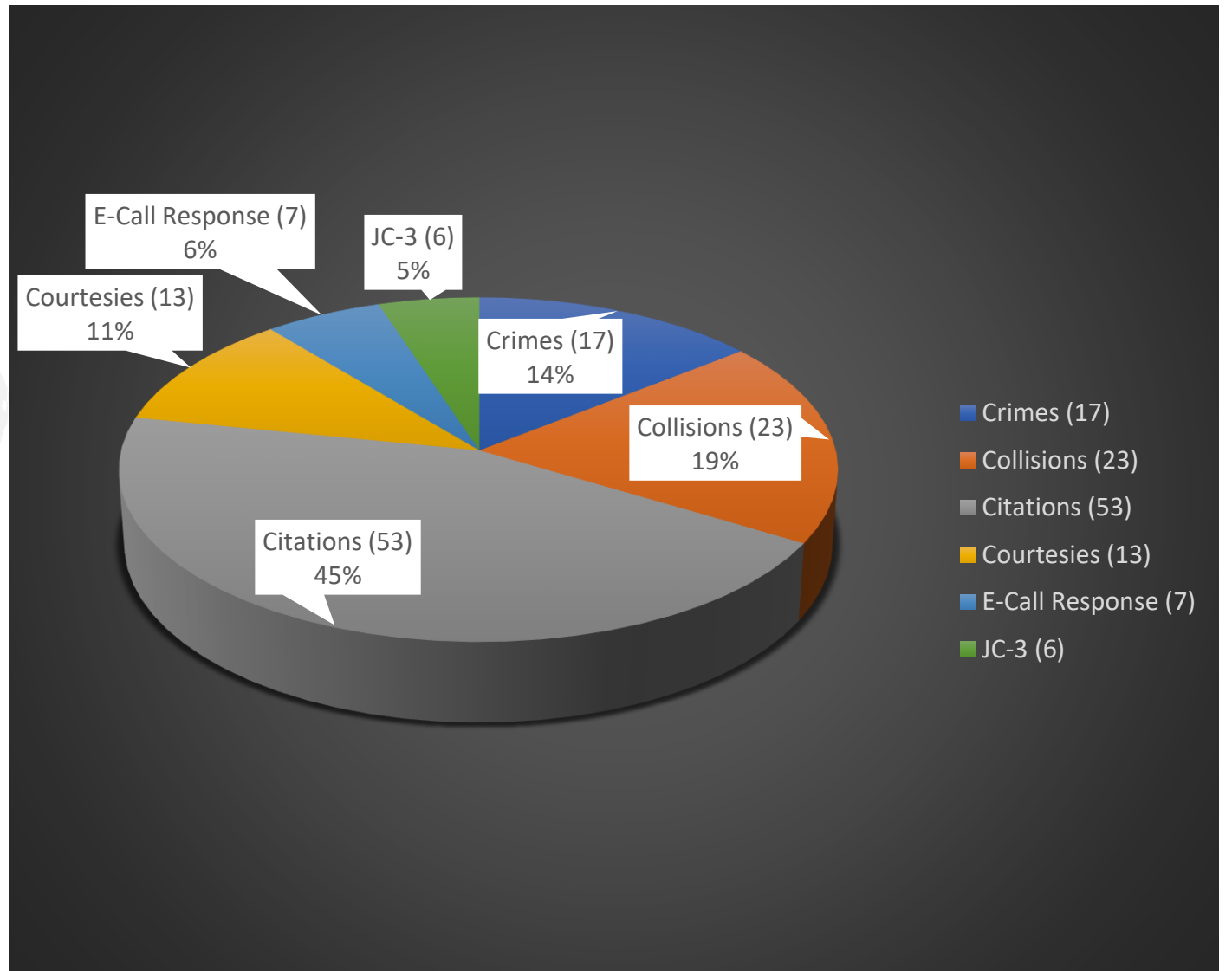

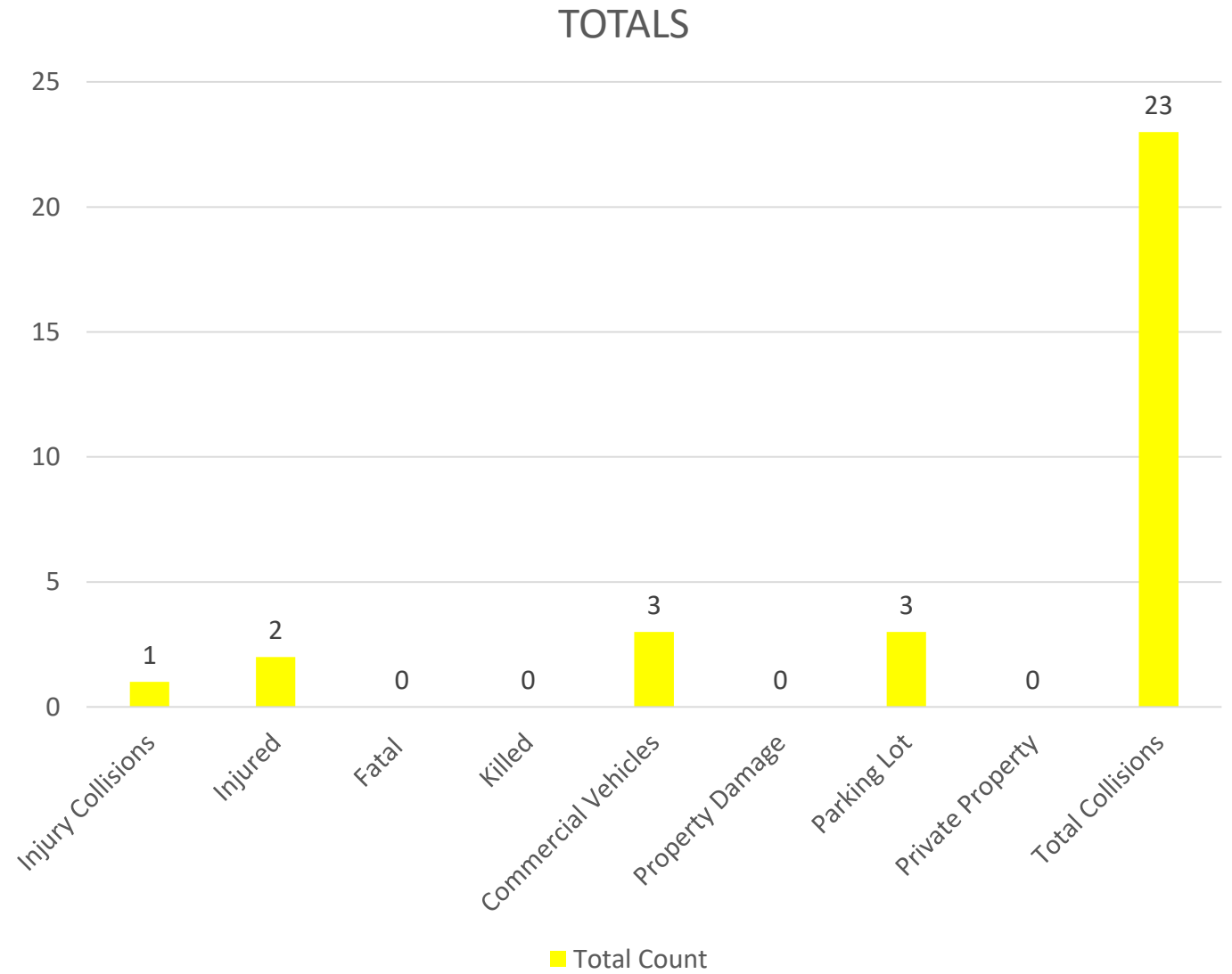

2023-23573 – Taylor Mill Road. Suspect identified and also set another fire in Boone County. Warrants issued. Suspect allegedly in Texas.

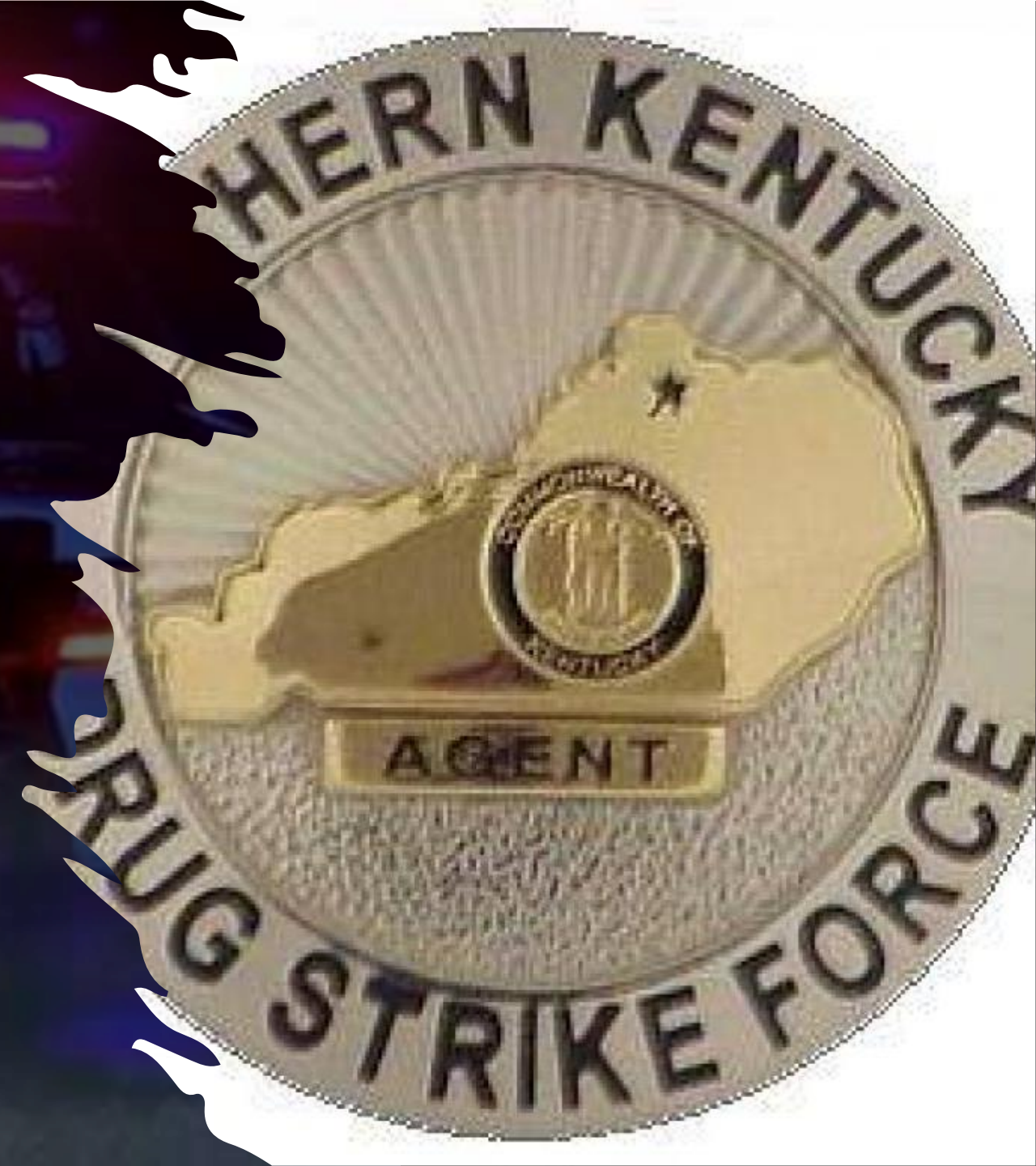
11484 Staffordsburg Road Fire – Fire deemed electrical. Other charges for occupants for various charges not related to fire. (Handled by KCPD)

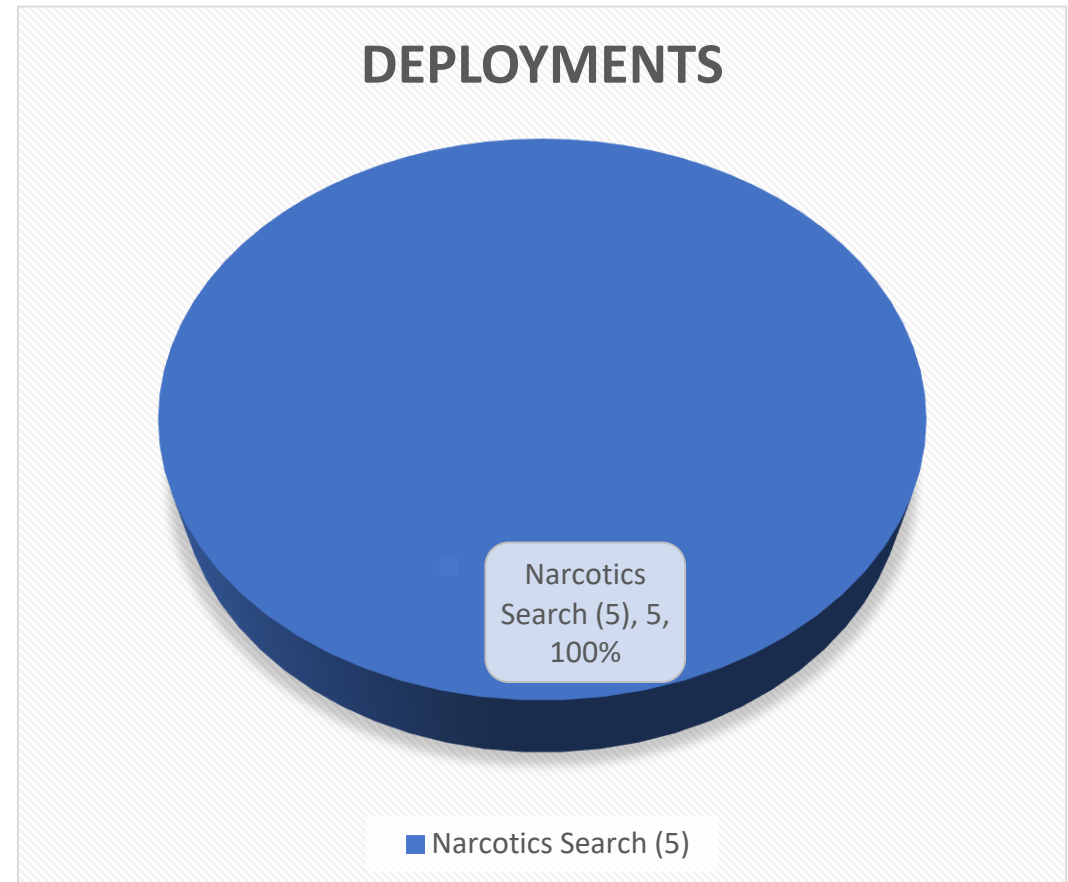

Credited with 2 Felony Arrests and numerous charges.



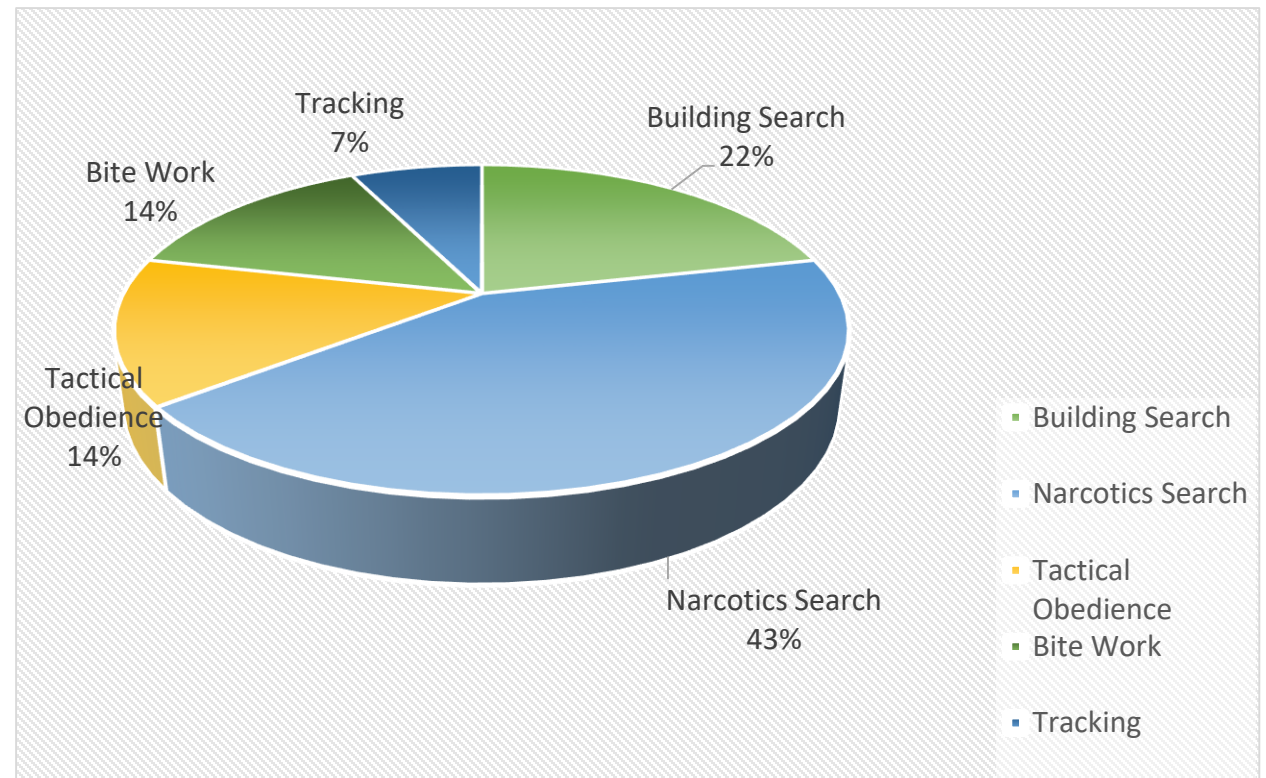

DEPARTMENT OVERTIME



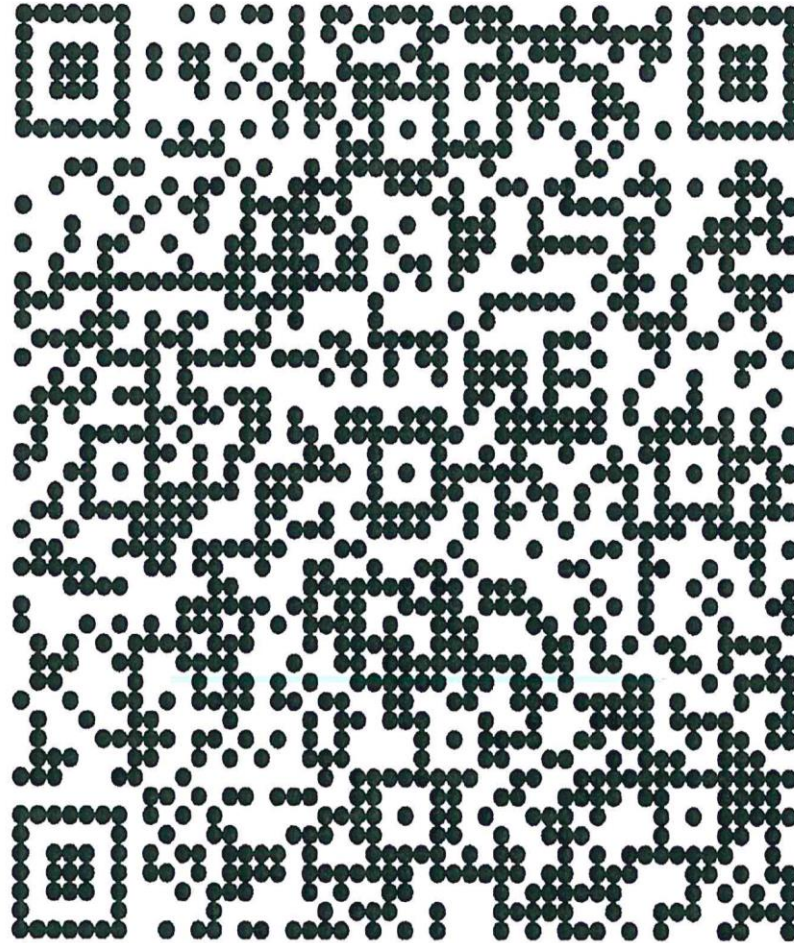
- Highway Safety (FOT) – 13.5
