

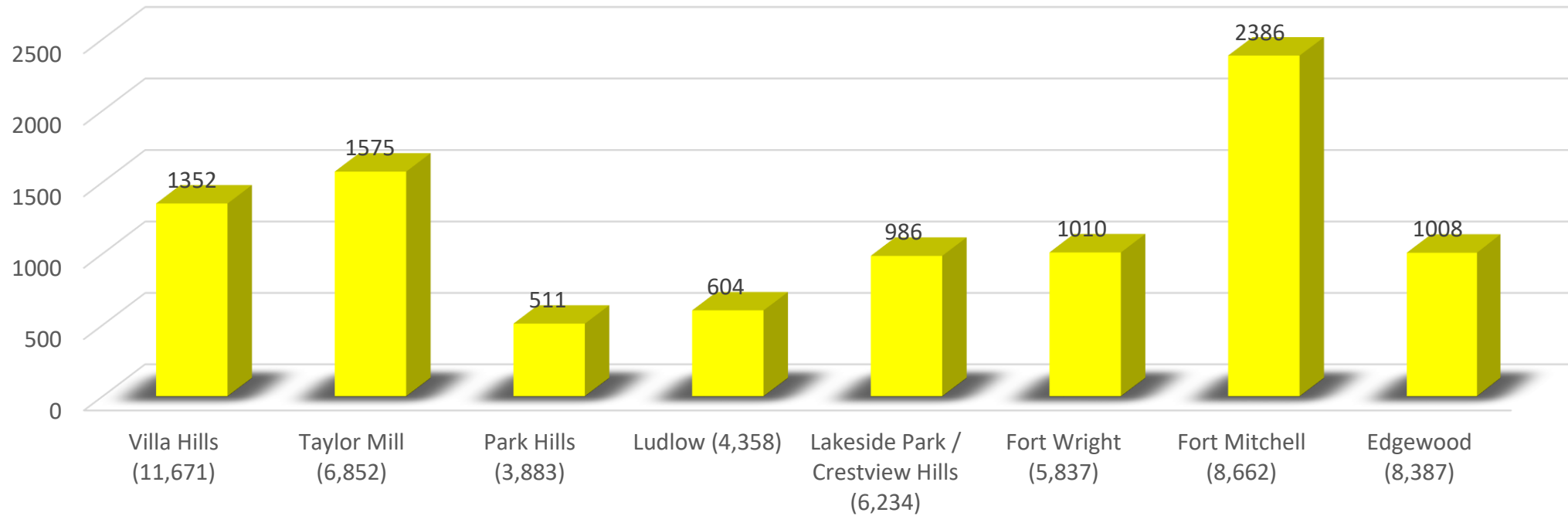

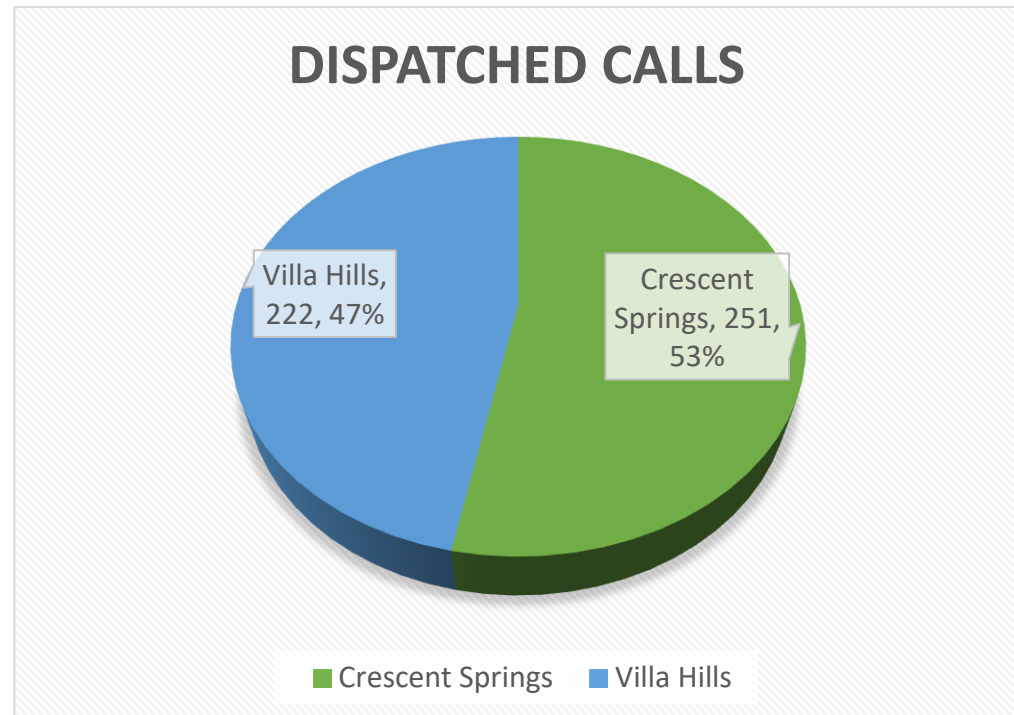
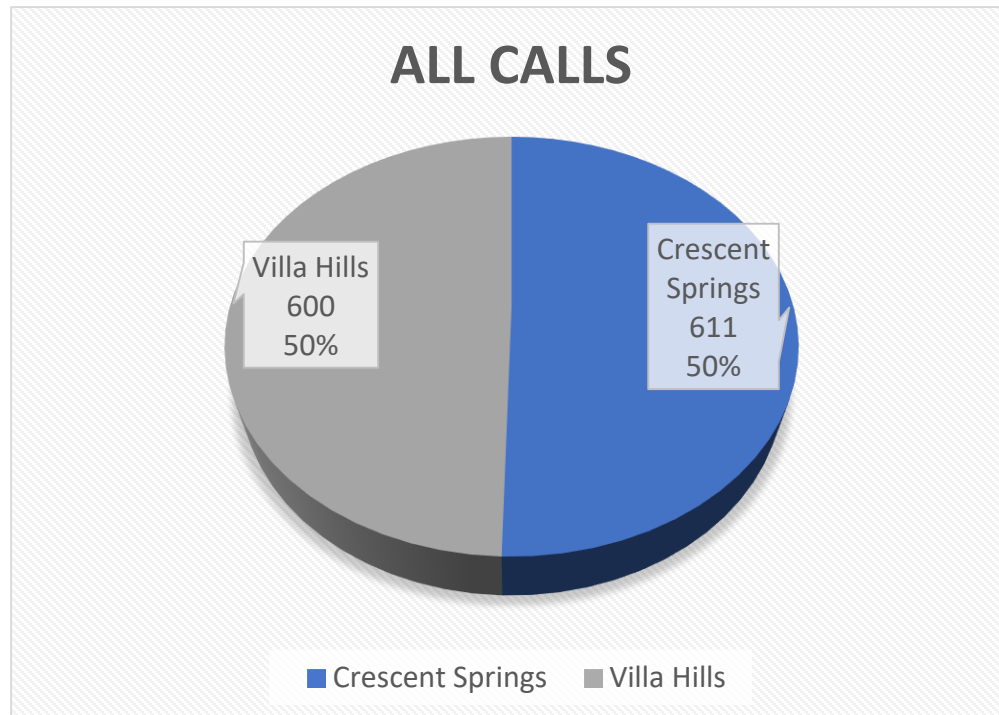
## CALLS FOR SERVICE



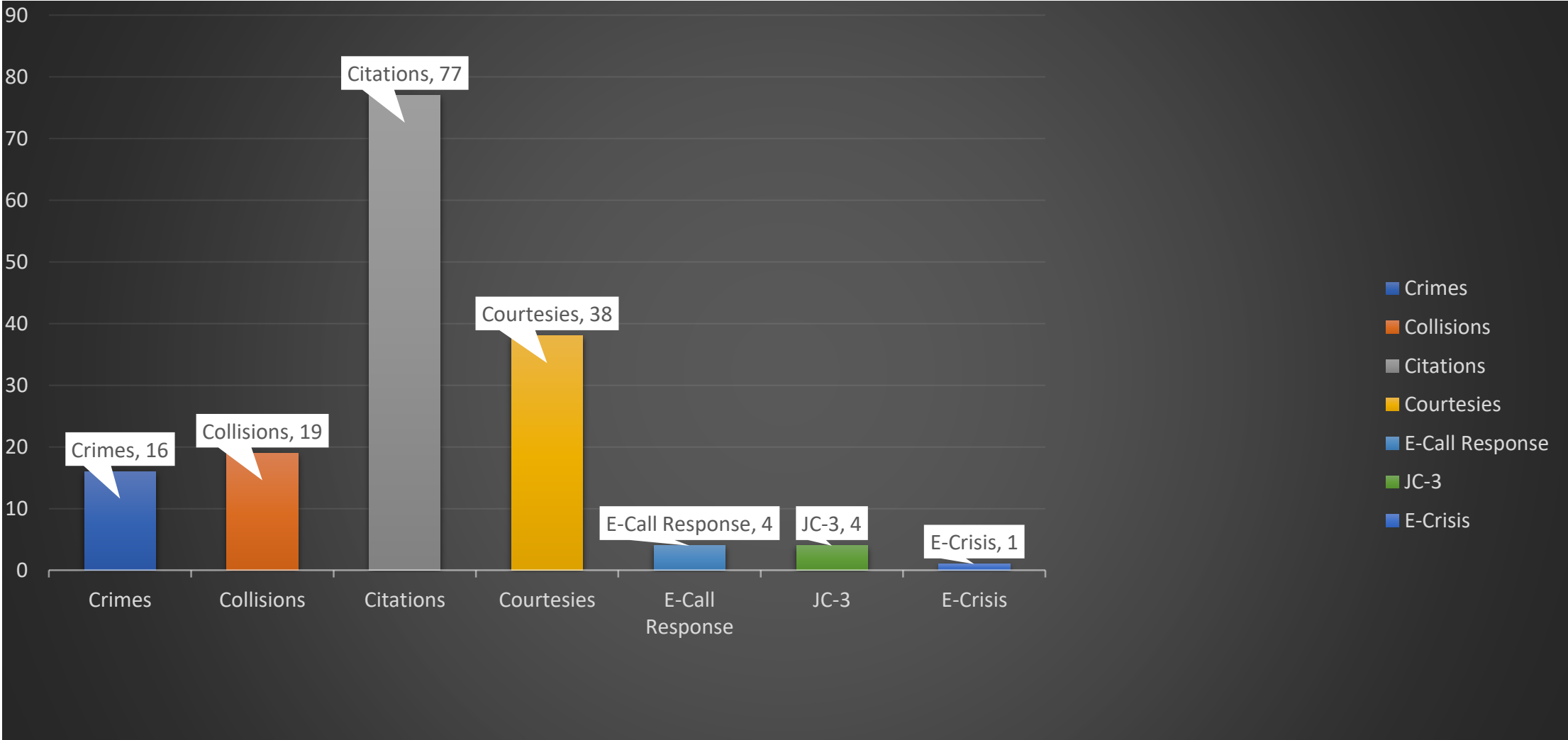
# FEBRUARY 2024 CALLS FOR SERVICE BY CITY

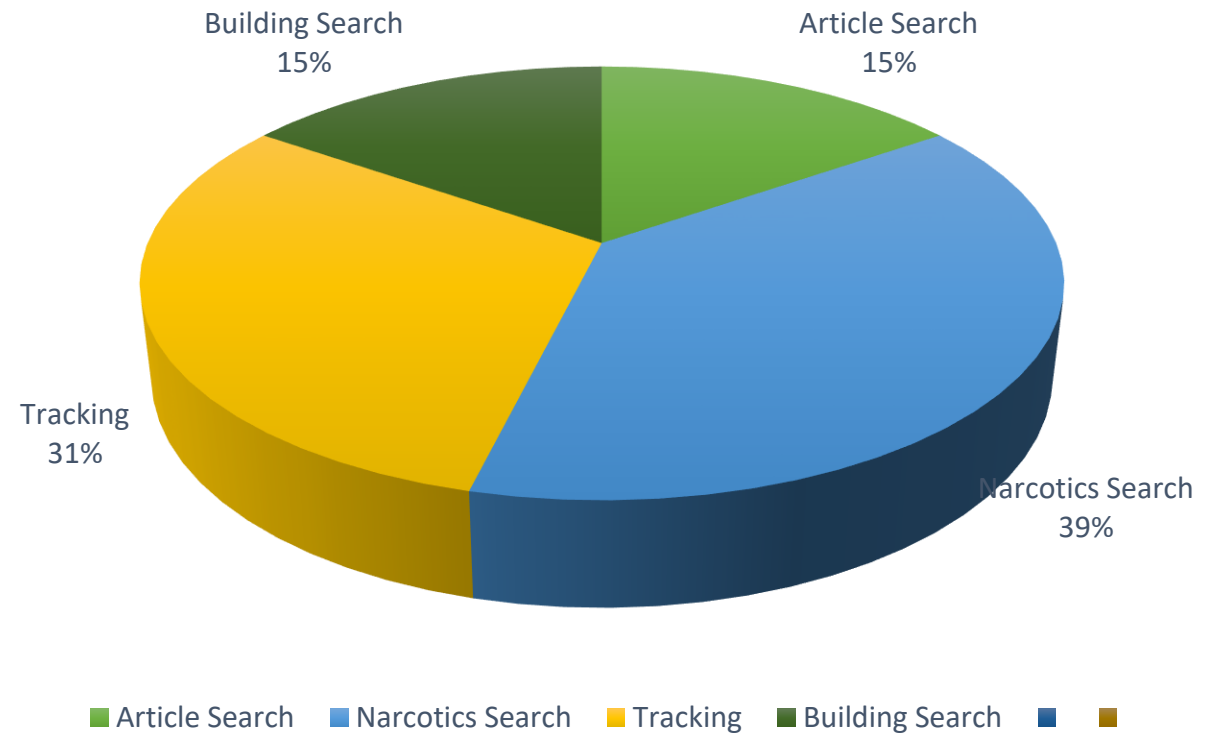
