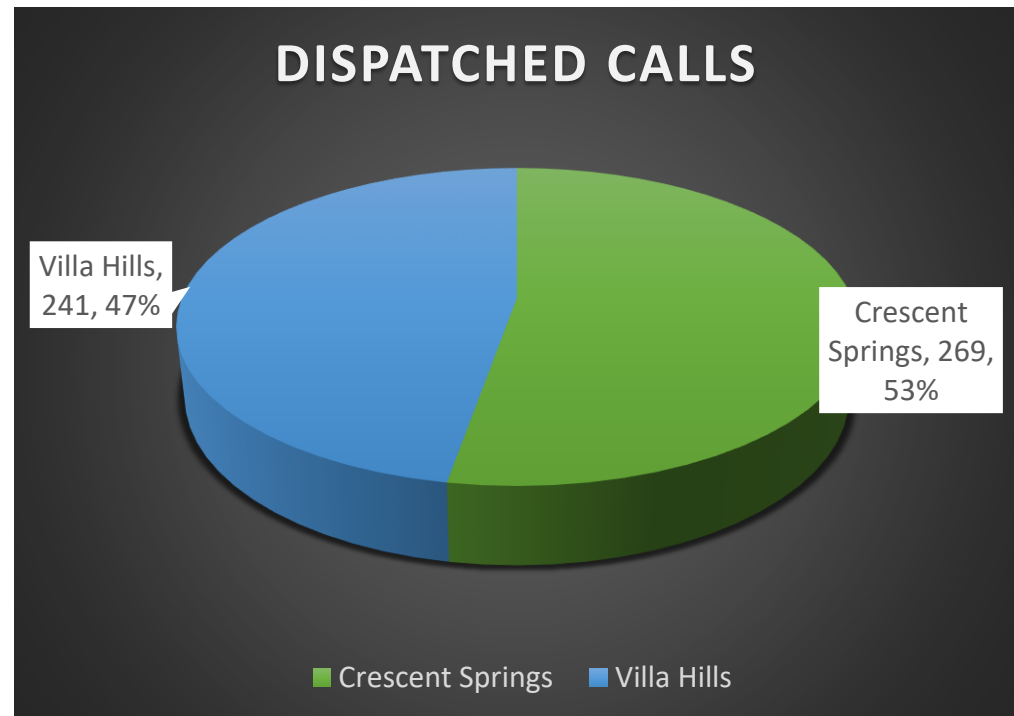

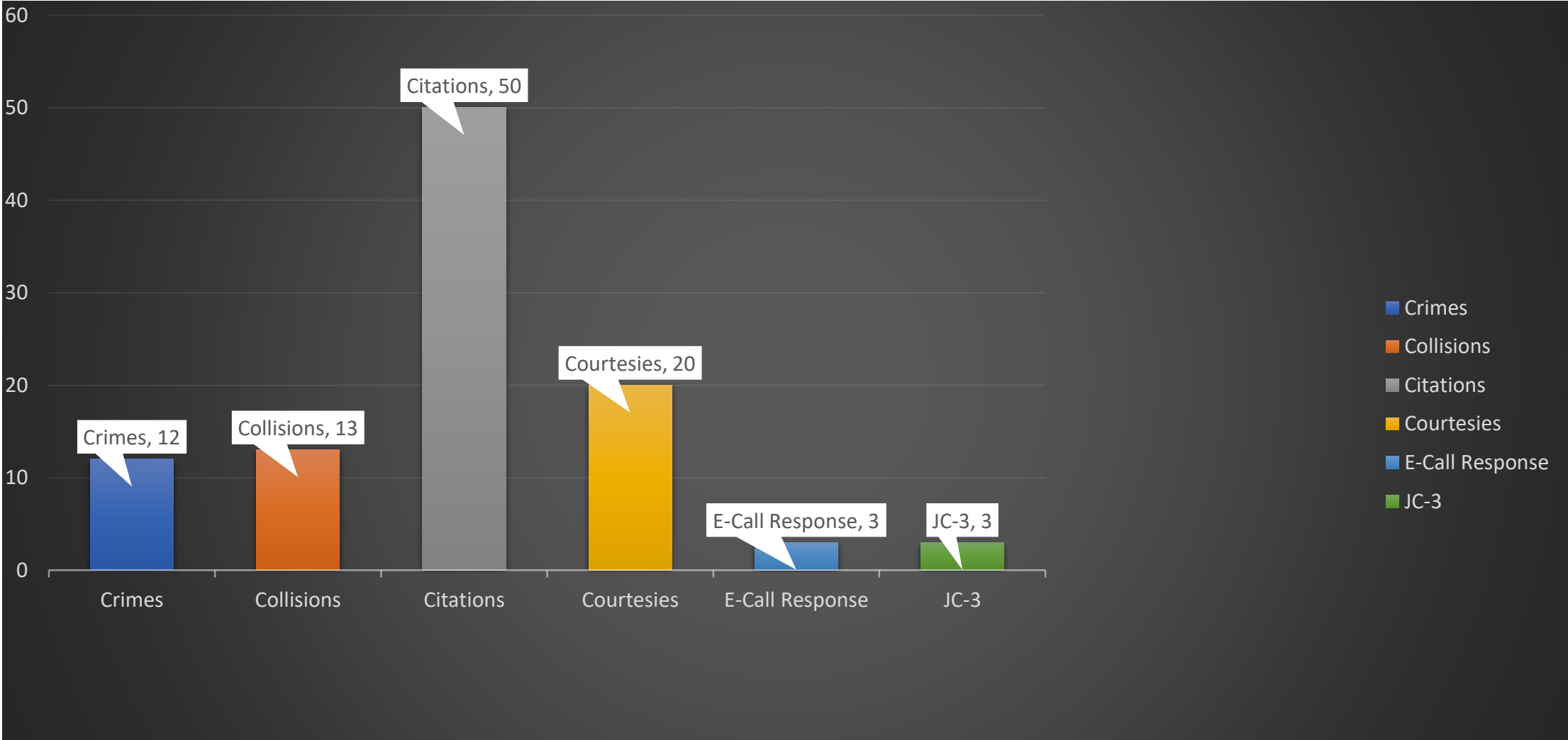
JANUARY 2024 CALLS FOR SERVICE BY CITY

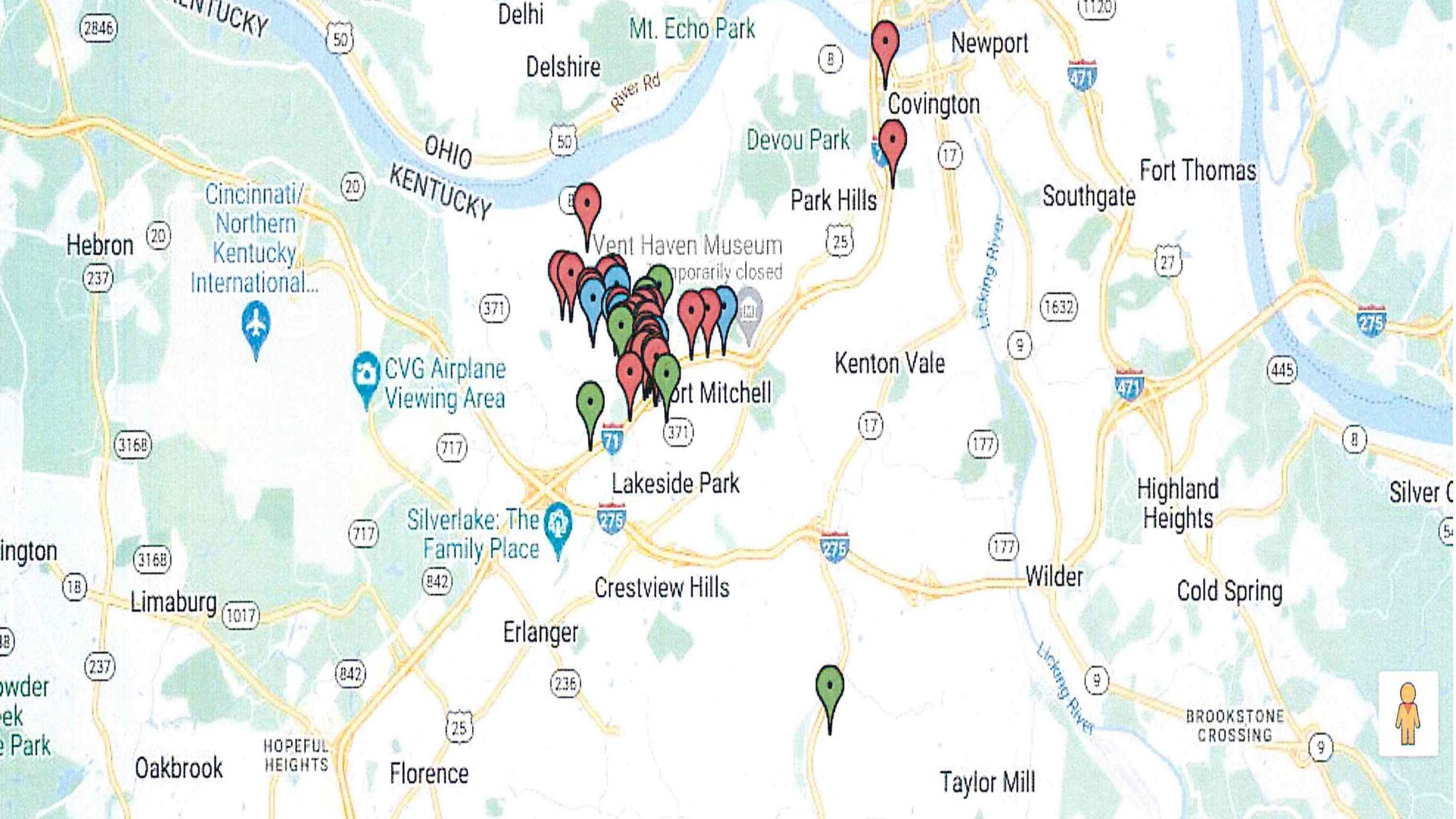

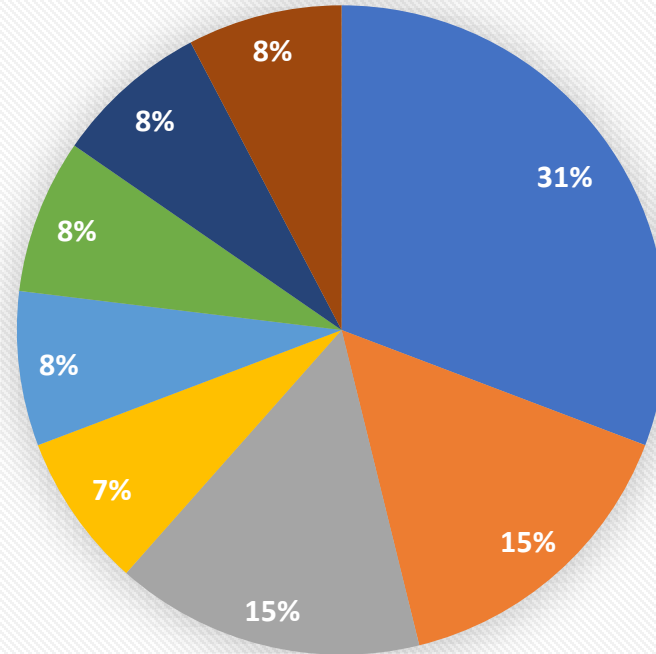

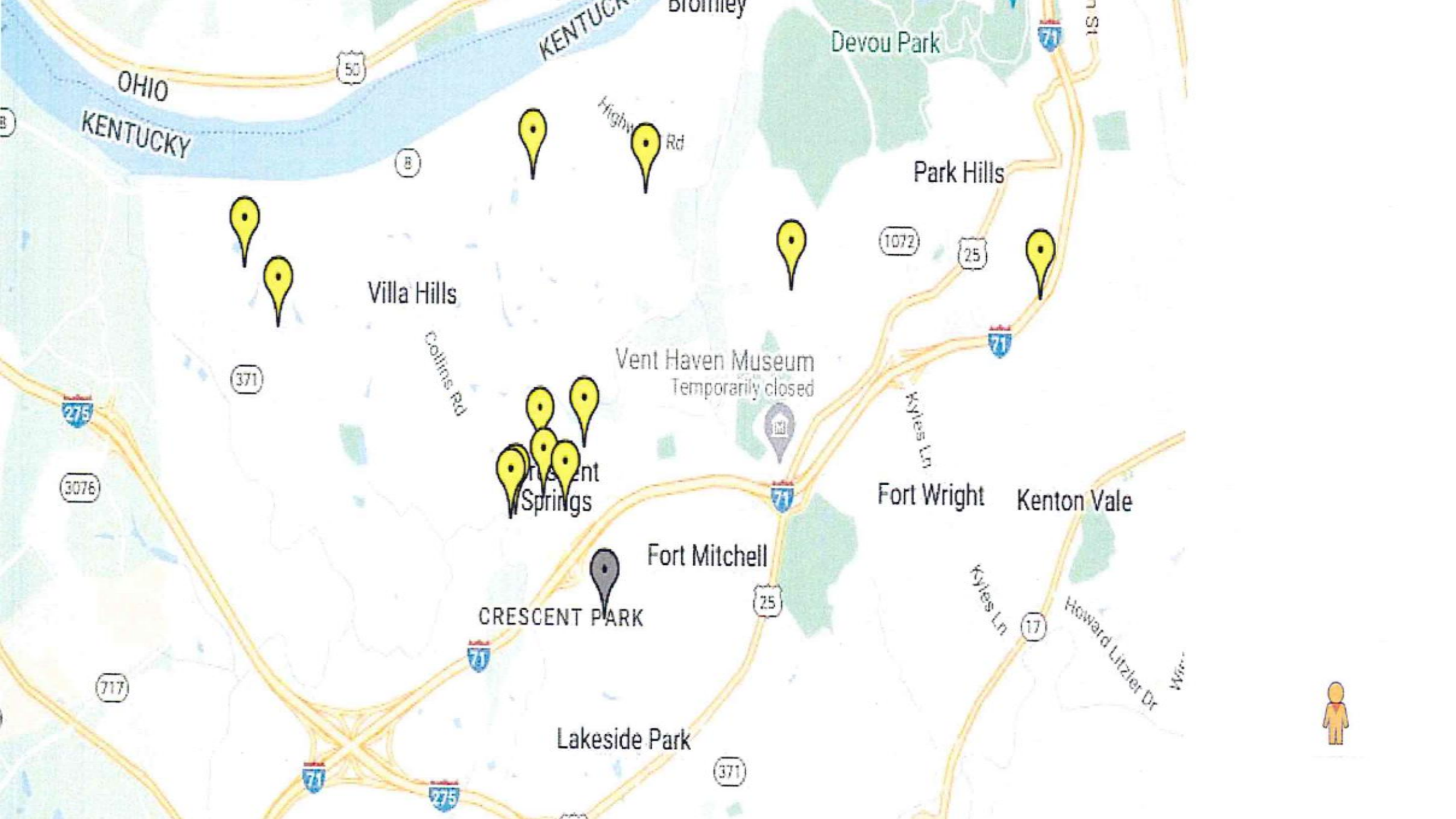


Top Roadway Collisions

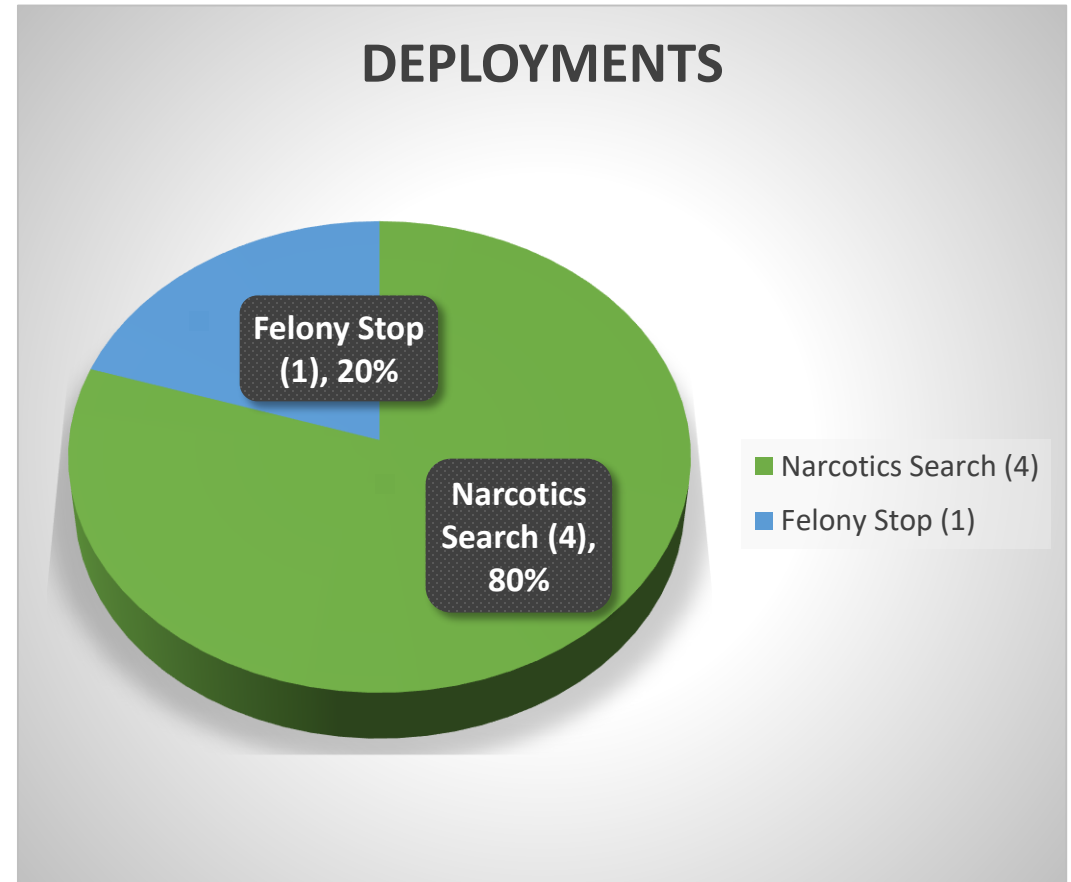

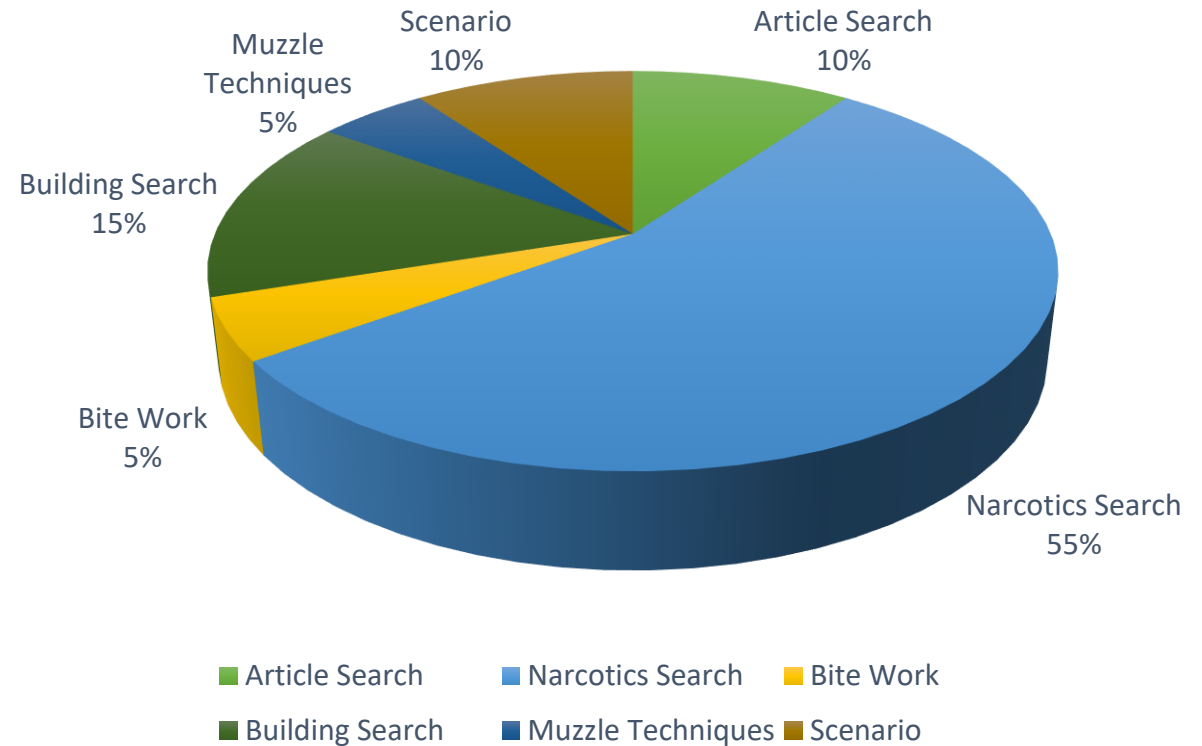
