

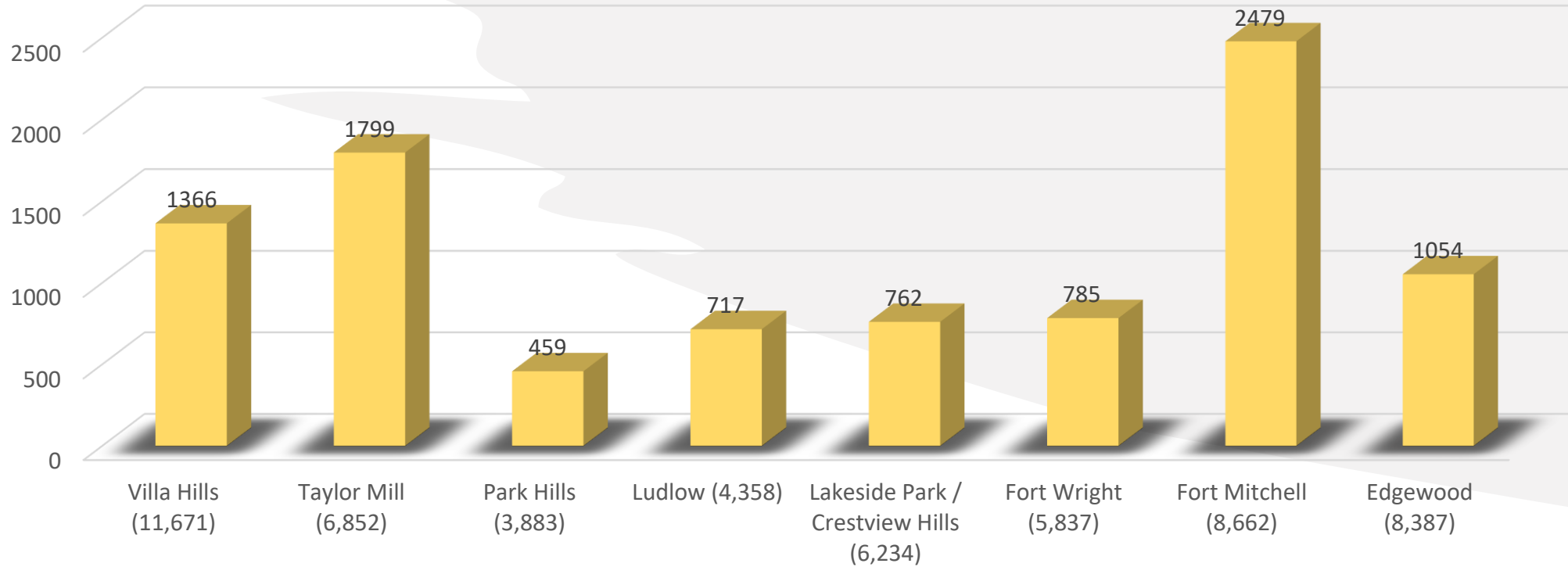

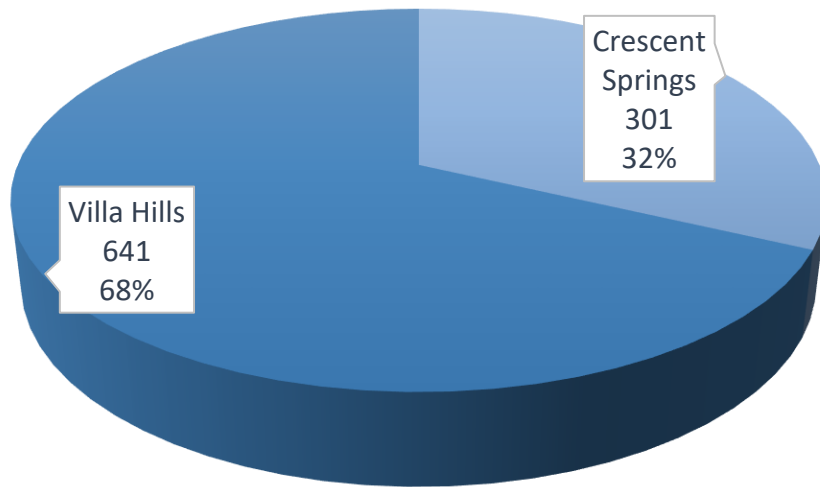


# SEPTEMBER 2024 CALLS FOR SERVICE BY CITY

ALL CALLS (INCLUDES SELF-INITIATED)

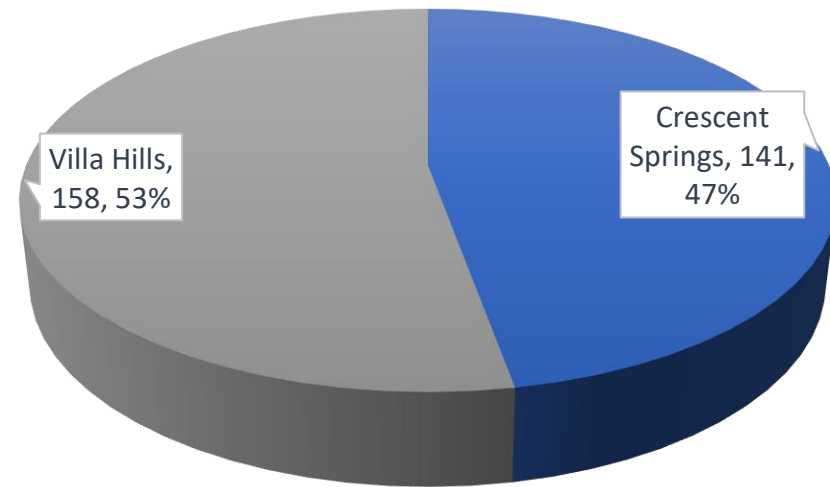

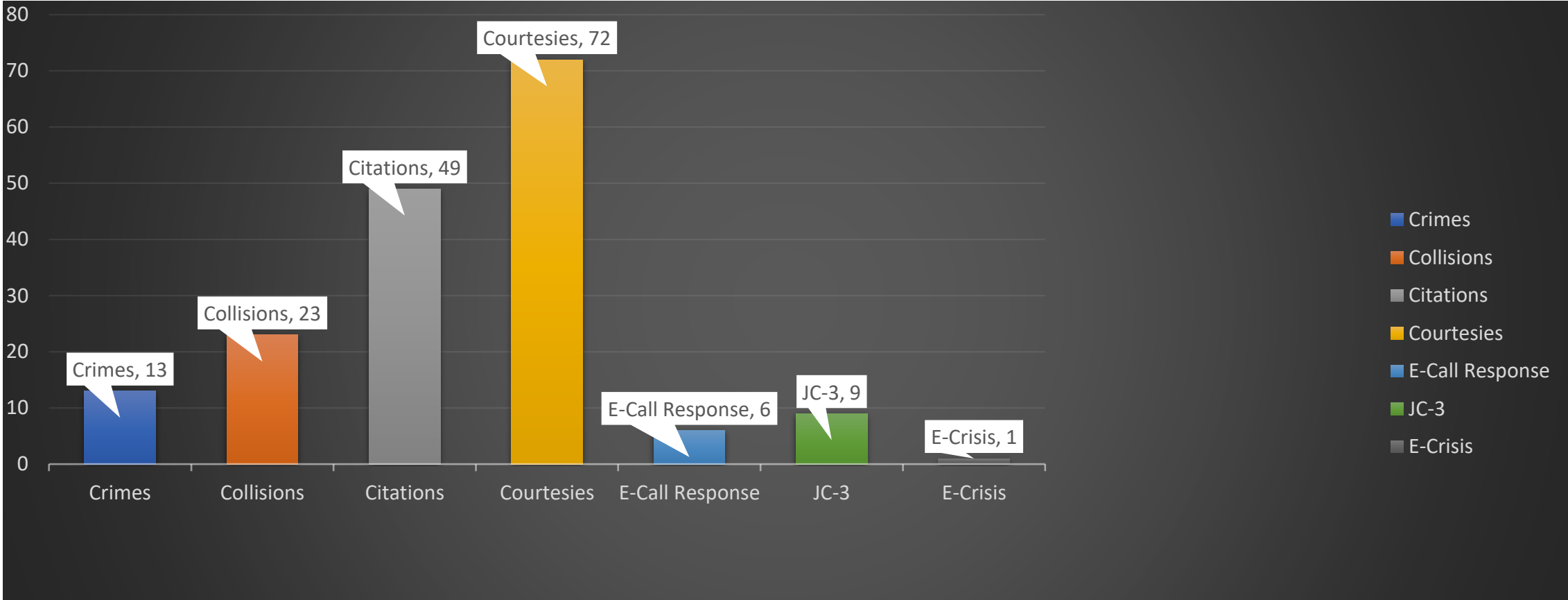

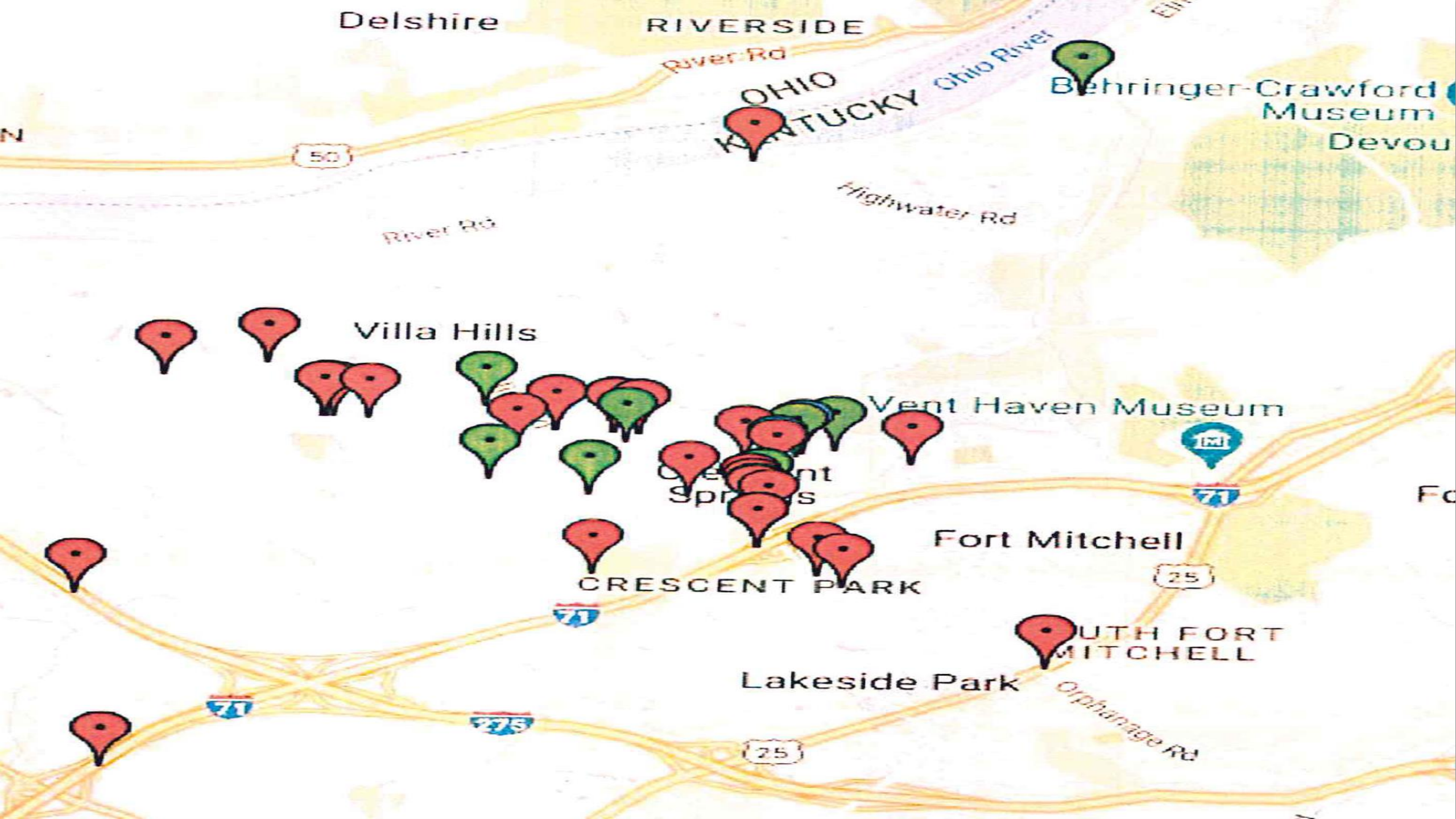

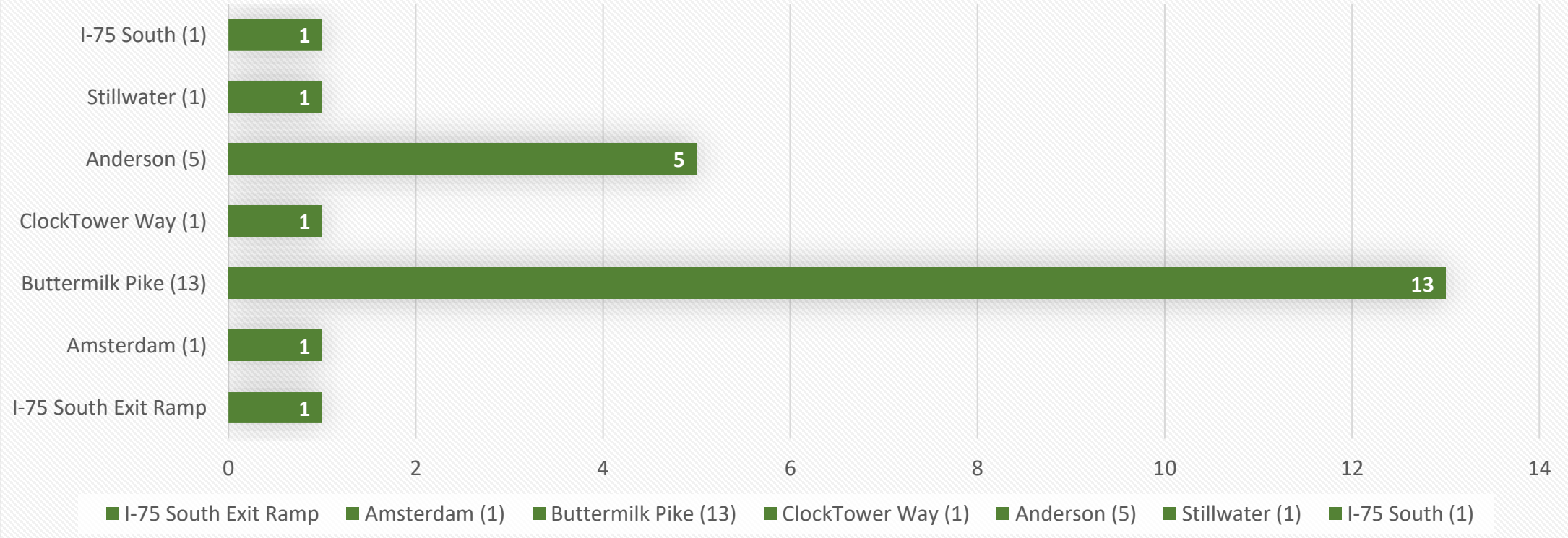

# **CRIMINAL** **INVESTIGATIONS** **REPORT**

- 2024-07408 (Theft >\$10,000) – Bank fraud. Working with FBI and Cincinnati Police. Subpoenas to be returned. Photos sent to FBI for facial recognition.
- 2021-10321 (Rape 1<sup>st</sup>) – Case under review by Commonwealth Attorney. (No Update)
- 2024-07928 (Sexual Assault Juvenile) – CAC Interview conducted. Case file sent to Commonwealth for review.
- 2024-08436 (Sexual Assault Juvenile) – CAC interview conducted. Investigation continues. Lab results pending. Still waiting for results.
- 2024-08539 (Fraud/Theft) – Possible suspect identified. More documents retrieved. Case Continues.
- 2024-09208 (Fraud/Theft) – Bitcoin scam. Search warrant and subpoenas sent.
- 2024-09387 (Fraud/Theft) – Bitcoin scam. Loss of \$25,000. Waiting for return of subpoenas.
- 2024-10073 (Possession of Forged Instrument 2<sup>nd</sup>) –Getting ID of suspect and will pursue charges.

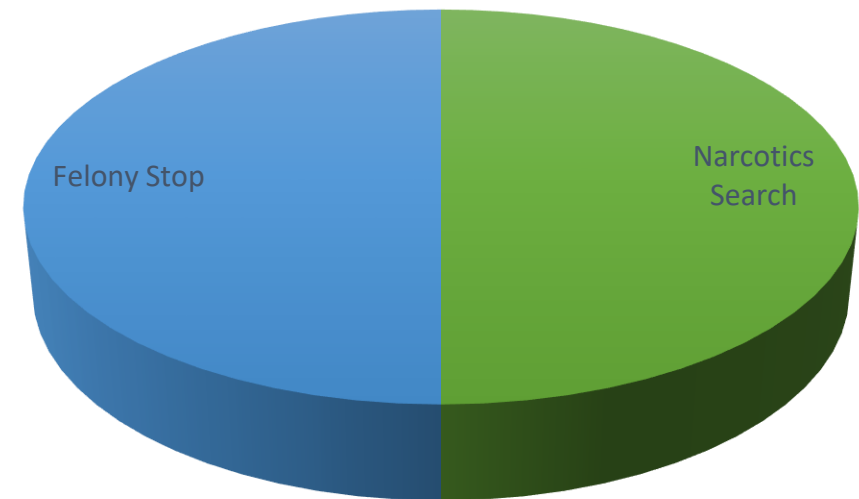
