CITY OF VILLA HILLS, KENTUCKY

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE KENTON COUNTY FISCAL COURT AND THE CITIES OF BROMLEY AND CRESCENT SPRINGS TO UPDATE THE 2009 ROAD MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, Bromley, Villa Hills, and Kenton County have previously agreed to share maintenance responsibilities for certain roadways or portions thereof in their respective jurisdictions by virtue of a tri-party services agreement dated December 9, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereby agree that the December 9, 2009 agreement no longer reflects the current maintenance needs for the area and the inclusion of the City of Crescent Springs to this new road maintenance agreement is necessary and beneficial to the Citizens of Kenton County

WHEREAS, The members of the City Council have reviewed the proposed Interlocal Agreement and have concluded that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Villa Hills, Kentucky;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS:

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Villa Hills the Interlocal Agreement with the Kenton County Fiscal Court and the Cities Bromley and Crescent Springs for the road maintenance and snow removal of various streets. A copy of said Interlocal Agreement appears as Exhibit "A" and is subject to the approval of the Kenton County Fiscal Court, the cities of Bromley and Crescent Springs and the Attorney General or Department of Local Government.


