

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE CITY’S BUDGET AND ORDINANCE 2025-6 BY ADJUSTING REVENUE AND EXPENSES IN THE GENERAL FUND. THIS IS AN AMENDED BUDGET ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, PURSUANT TO KRS 91A.030(10) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2025 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026, BY ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF CITY GOVERNMENT AND PROVIDING THAT NO MONIES SHALL BE EXPENDED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF VILLA HILLS EXCEPT IN ACCORDANCE HEREWITH.**

Be it ordained by the City of Villa Hills, Kentucky as follows:

**Section I:** Pursuant to the requirements of KRS 91A.030(10), the City of Villa Hills shall during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026 operate and be operated pursuant to the budget set forth in Section II; and no monies shall be expended by or on behalf of the City of Villa Hills except in accordance therewith.


**Section VII:** All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.


**Section VIII:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication, which may be in summary form, and recording, according to law.
