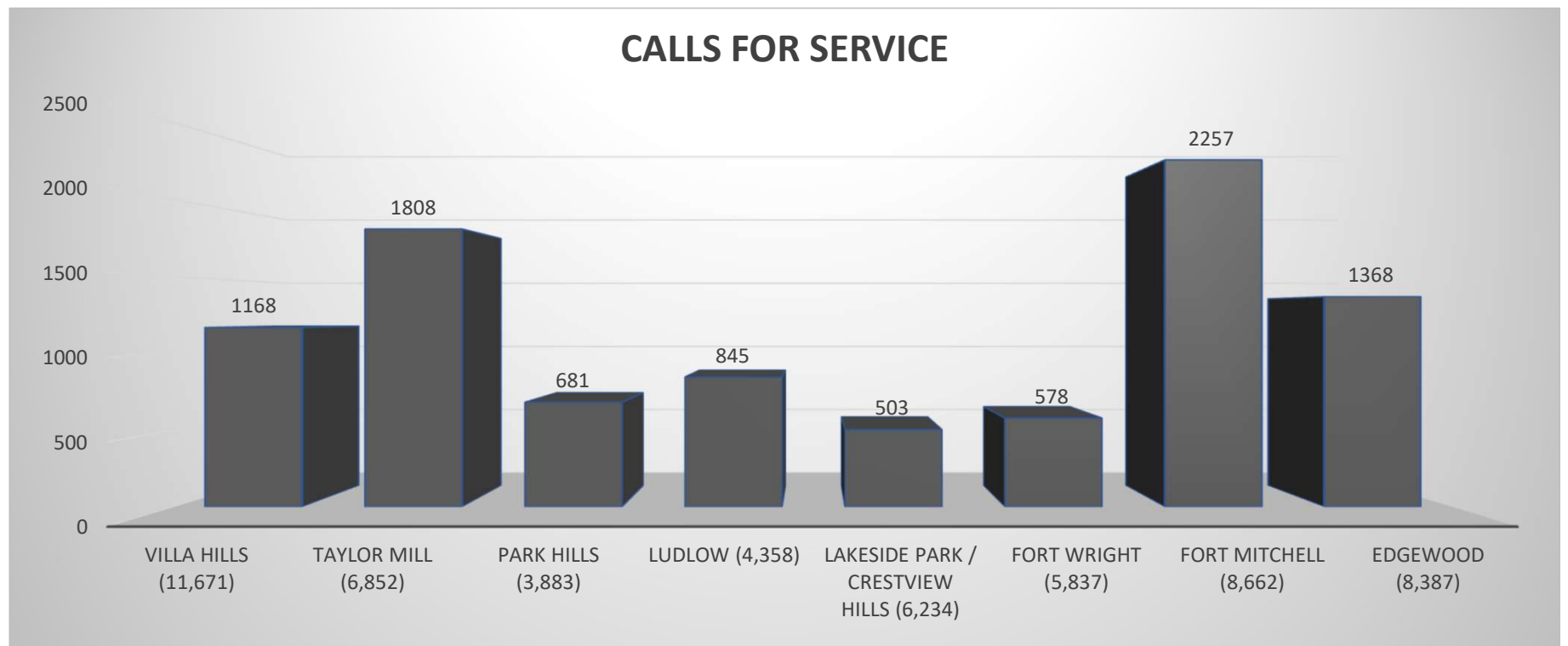

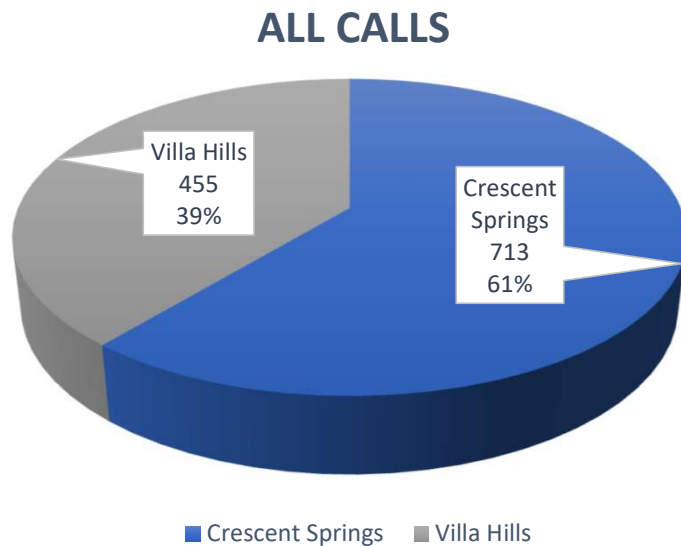


FEBRUARY 2026 STATISTICS

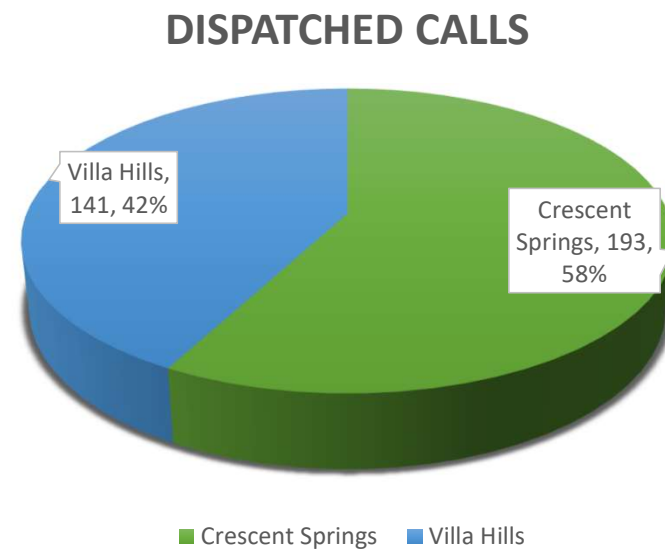


FEBRUARY 2026 CALLS FOR SERVICE BY CITY

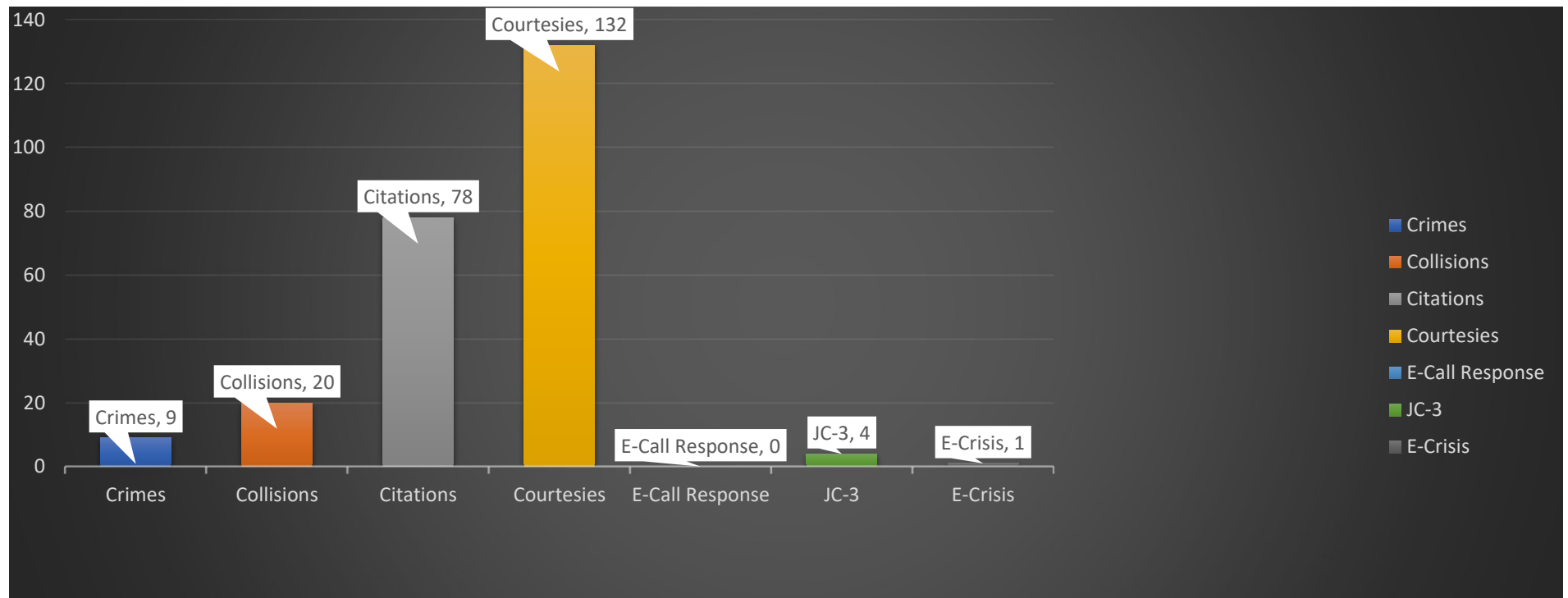
ALL CALLS (INCLUDES SELF-INITIATED)

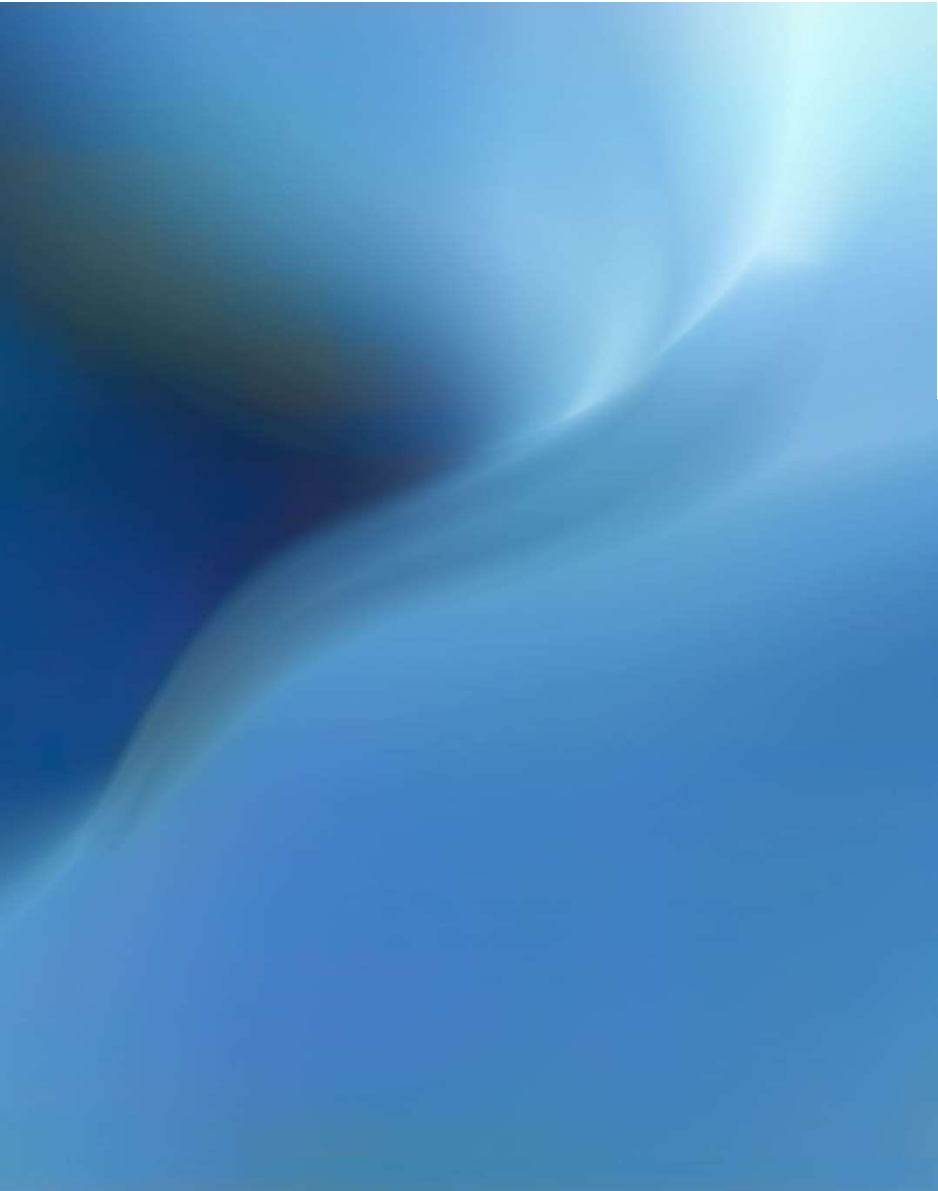


DISPATCHED CALLS (EXCLUDES ALL OTHERS)



Department Activity February 2026



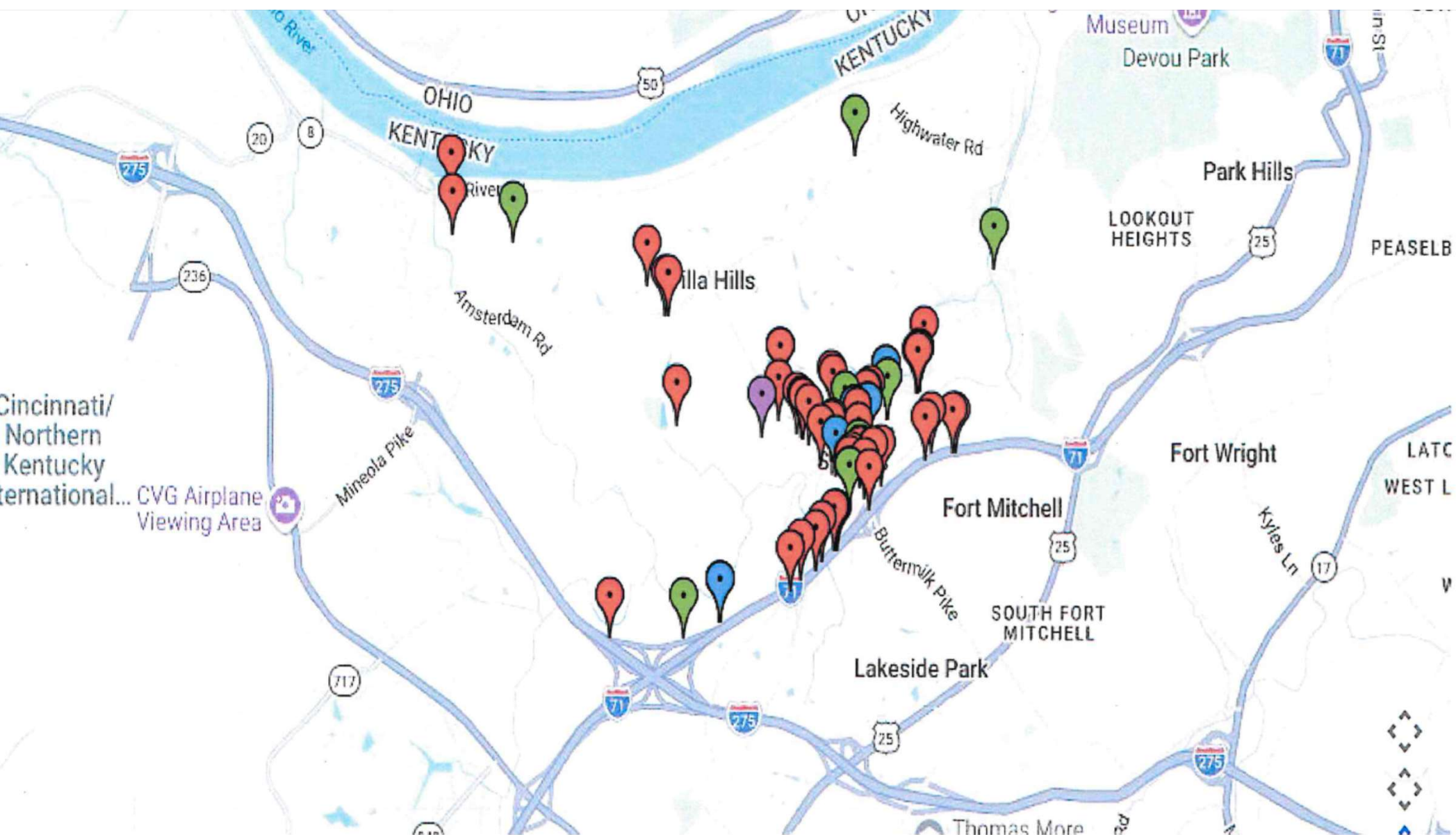


CITATIONS BY TYPE

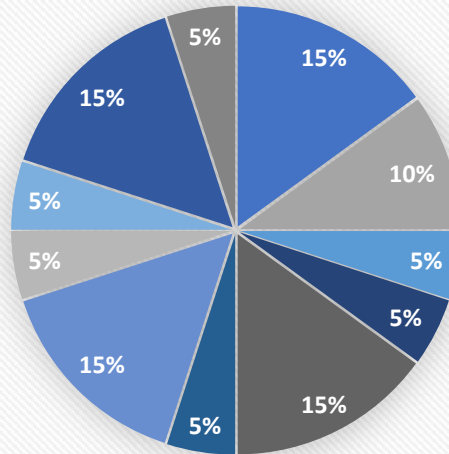
Red – Traffic Stops (59)

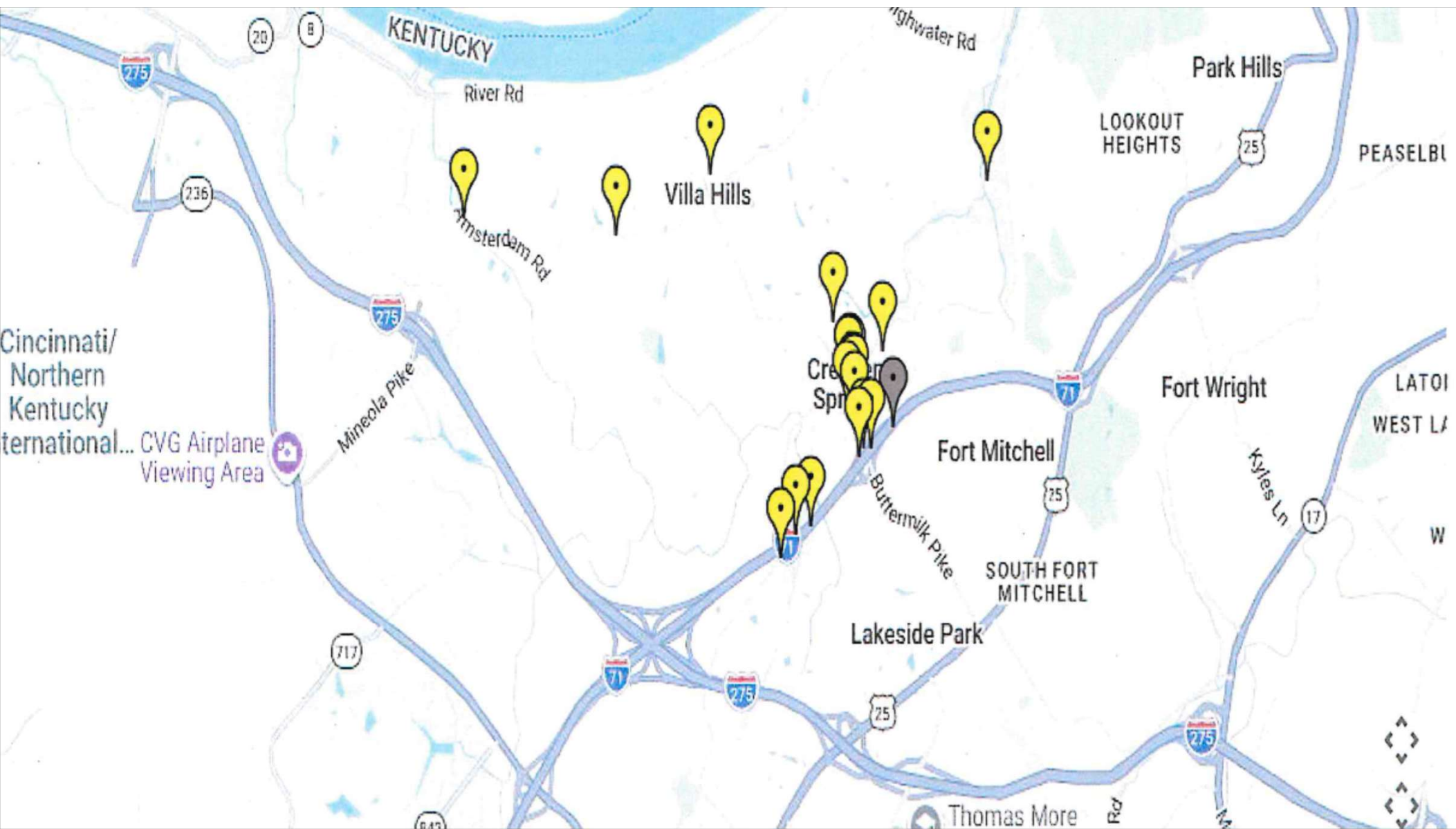


Top Roadway Collisions

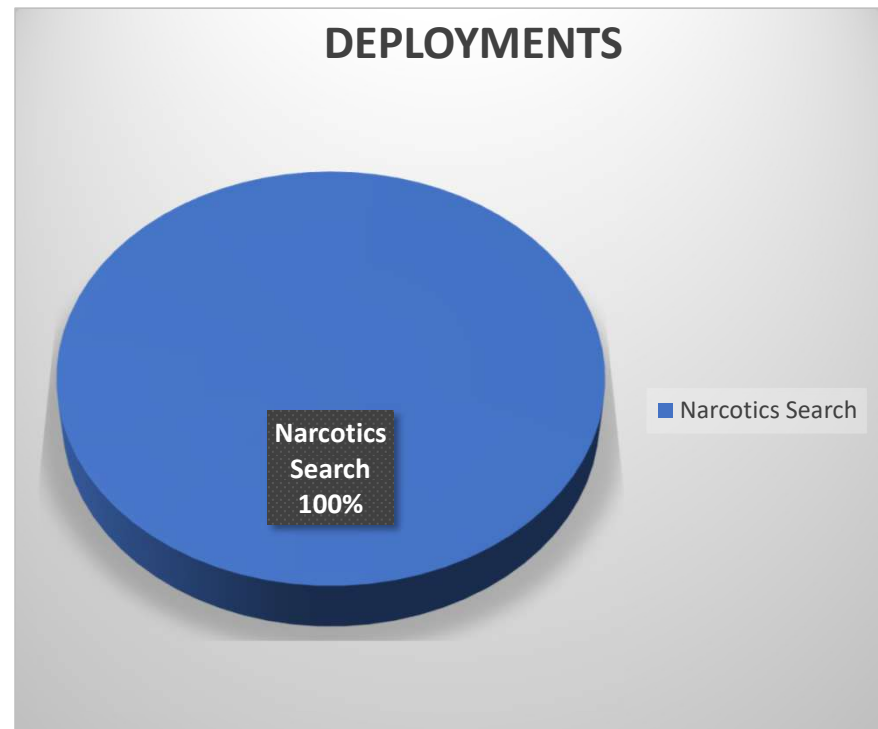

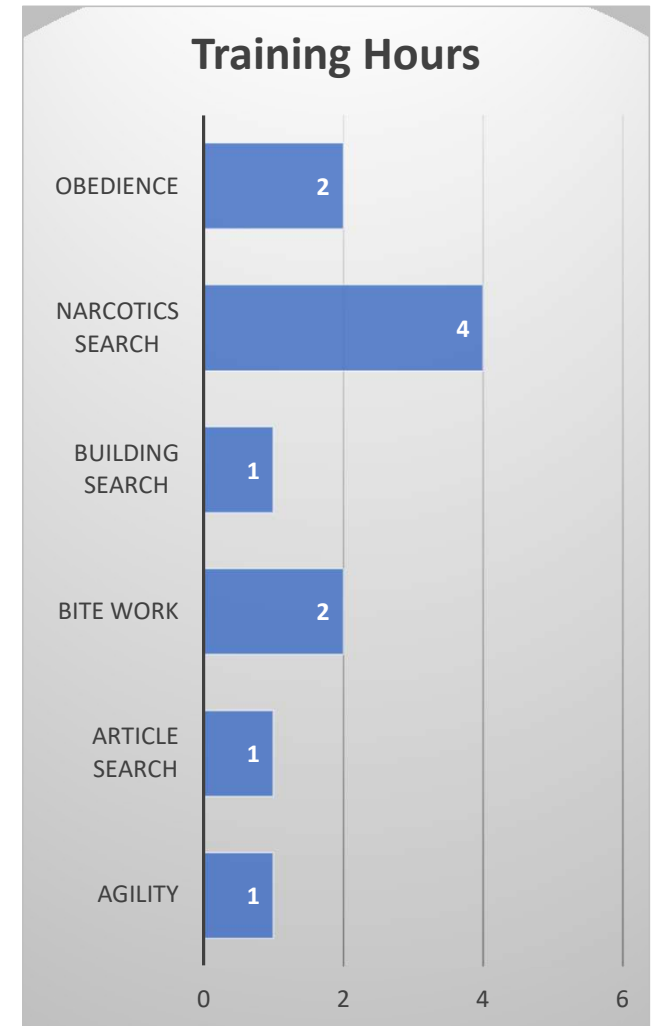
